You will readily appreciate the fact that large Steamers to carry coals, etc. have to be booked as they are available, and that it is not possible to arrange such shipments at regular inter vals only. As it will be impossible to rely upon the Uganda Railway being able to carry this quantity to where it might he required immediately on arrival, and as further it might be expedient not to send it up w the line at once, it would certainly be necessary to provide considerable storage space for this purpose.
