

Sir.

Replying further to your No 4241/1901, I regret to inform you that after applying in every conceivable direction for employment, I have been unsuccessful. If it were possible for me to undertake the duties of a ship's Officer I should not have much difficulty but, the physical exertion required is too much for me at present, as it is I am obliged to seek some lighter work, which is extremely difficult to obtain.

I feel bound to again appeal to you to try & assist me. I am quite confident that if I could find something of a sedentary nature either here or abroad I could safely undertake it.

My position has become so acute that unless I hear of something shortly, I shall be obliged to sacrifice my home, this anxiety is a very great strain. I am certain that with employment my health would improve. Under the circumstances the salary would not be so much an object as settled occupation.
