My Lord,

With reference to Head II, paragraph 6 of Your Lordship's despatch No. 129 of the 11th ultime respecting the Estimate of £300 for Legal Libraries I have the honour to report that this sum covers the cost of the High Court and Town Magistrates Libraries at Mombasa, Nairobi and Kisumu, and the supply of necessary law books to all the Courts of the Protectorate.

2. Provision to this extent will not be required in future, extra expenditure this year and last having been necessitated in order to equip the Nairobi Library and bring it up to date in the matter of Law Reports.

3. As Your Lordship is aware, works of this nature are somewhat expensive but I anticipate that in 1911-12 the amount can be reduced to £100. I trust, however, that this year's vote may be allowed to stand at the original figure.
