My Lord,

With further reference to head 21 paragraph 8 of H.R. Lordship's despatch No. 129 of the 11th ult. in which I am asked to state the present position as regards the establishment of a system of wireless telegraphy between this Protectorate, Mombasa, Somaliland and Zanzibar I have the honour to report that I do not see my way to incurring expenditure in this connection at present.

2. The Postmaster General is however in direct official communication with the legal syndicate and it is possible that the latter may be prepared to make and work an installation at Mombasa at their own expense, under an agreement giving the Government power to take over later on if desired.
