My Lord,

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of the 2nd of the 21st September 1910, from the Secretary of the East Africa Protectorate, Nairobi, in relation to the proposed transfer of the headquarters of the East Africa Protectorate from Nairobi to Heligoland. I have the honor to submit the further information requested.

1. The total estimated cost of the proposed transfer of the headquarters of the East Africa Protectorate from Nairobi to Heligoland is about £250,000, which would be sufficient to cover the cost of the building of a strong rock with all the necessary fittings.

The cost of the transfer of the special forces would be estimated at £100,000, which would be met by the British Government, and would be included with the cost.

The recurrent expenditure on the proposed transfer of the headquarters of the East Africa Protectorate from Nairobi to Heligoland is estimated at £100,000 per annum, which would be met by the British Government.
