The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the
Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office, 18.10.10. at 10.30 A.M.)

Firstly, Sir, the statements in the Press
have by me been and are followed up and re-inforced,
and have agreed with information here. I had ample
opportunity of communicating with you of venturing a few
words in Council. Except in small letters, however,
the bulk of my information is from the following
sources. You will understand as to the intentions
of the Government in this matter. I would be glad
to take the whole question of policy with you at
home, but I cannot leave this country without taking
some notice. There are two courses which it seems
open to us to adopt:- firstly, to say in reply to
questions that the Government intends to make a
full enquiry - this will not be sufficient;
secondly to Sir. Mysore, who represents a Council, if
induced to do so, to state what is in the Press, and to
recommend that the Government instruct him
to do the same, and to do so together.
