Sir:-

I have received your despatch No. 2 of February 4th transmitting a memorandum concerning the Southern frontier of Abyssinia, and stating that you have informed Fitaurari Raptu-Gieris that you are prepared, pending the discussion at Addis Ababa of the question of the new line, to recognize the maintenance of frontier conditions as they were before Major Gwynn's survey.

Your action is approved provided that you make it quite clear to the Abyssinian Government that Her Majesty's Government intend to hold Major Gwynn's line as soon as the maps showing it reach Addis Ababa and can be explained to the Abyssinians.
