B.I.C.-

I have received your despatch No. 9 of February
in transmitting a memorandum concerning the Southern
frontier of Abyssinia, and stating that you have informed
Fitanari Hafta Giorgis that you are prepared,
pending the discussion at Addis Ababa of the question
of the frontier, to recognize the maintenance of front-
tier conditions as they were before Major Gwynn's
survey.

Your action in approved provision that does not
leave clear to the Abyssinian Government that the
Treaty's Government intend to hold Major Gwynn's line
such as the maps showing it reach Addis Ababa and
can be explained to the Abyssinians.
