With reference to your despatch No. 183 of 14th ultimo enquiring why the actual grants of land made during the latter half of 1904 were exclusively in the Ukamba

Province, I have the honour to report that it was only in that Province that finished survey plans were submitted, thus enabling the Land Officer to have title deeds prepared.

2. It will be found in the returns for the first half of 1905 that grants have also been made in other provinces and that many of the " pending " applications have been settled.
