REGULATIONS for the AUDIT of the accounts of the COMMISSIONERS of CURRENCY appointed under the Order in Council of 1862

1. The Local Auditor appointed under section 10 of the Order in Council of the 4th of March 1862 shall be responsible to the Commissioner for the correct and efficient audit and inspection of the accounts of the Currency Board, and shall at once bring to the notice of the Commissioner any breach in the provisions of the Order in Council for the proper keeping of the accounts.

1. The notes from which the new notes shall be printed shall be of such design and bear such devices as the Secretary of State shall approve, and shall be prepared by a person selected by the Crown Agents for the Colonies who shall be responsible for their safe custody.

2. The Currency Note shall be printed in such numbers and of such denominations as may from time to time be required under the supervision of the Crown Agents and supplied by them to the Currency Board.

3. The Currency Note shall be countermarked on behalf of the Currency Board by a specimen of the signature of the Secretary of State for Africa Protectorate for the time being.

4. The Currency Note shall be signed by the Secretary of State for Africa Protectorate and shall be called "the Currency Note" and the denomination shall be entered upon the reverse of the note.
