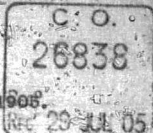

Sir,

I have had the honour to receive your despatch No. 243 of May 31st suggesting that the subsidy to Mr. Caine should be granted for three months longer before discontinuing it in order to enable him to modify his operations.

2. The subsidy was only guaranteed for one year and it has been already continued for a further period of six months. Mr. Caine's experiments have been on such a small scale that the subsidy must have more than covered the expense, and Mr. Caine has benefited to the extent that the crops grown and the land cleared are now his property.

I am informed by the Director of Agriculture that he is under the impression that Mr. Caine has not spent a sufficient proportion of his subsidy in developing the
