10. *Leucostoma* *luteum* (L.) Pers. (Fig. 10). - A small, slender, erect, branching shrub, 1-2 m. tall, with a few scattered hairs on the young twigs; lvs. opposite, elliptic-lanceolate, acute, 10-15 mm. long, 5-7 mm. wide, glabrous above, pubescent below; fls. yellow, 5-petaled, 10-12 mm. in diameter, in terminal cymes.
