My Lord,

I venture to respectfully remind you, that I have received no reply from the Colonial Office, concerning the transfer of the Lease of the Araboko Forest to Mr.Pauling.

I understood from the Permanent Department that the matter would have to be referred to H.M. Commissioner of the Rast Africa Protectorate pending whose reply no decision could be given. Some months have now elapsed since I made my first application, and I venture to think that ample time has been allowed for the definite settlement of this question.

As this prolonged delay is causing great inconvenience, and militating vary much against doing anything with the Forest this Season, I would be much obliged if you would kindly give the matter your best attention.
