Sir,

In accordance with the instructions contained in your minute, dated the 15th instant, on my letter No. 137/1610, dated 11th instant, I have issued orders to Mr. W. H. Townsend, Chief Officer of S.S. "Winifred" to relieve Capt. R. W. Farnall. Consequent on this date the following alterations will be effected.

Mr. W. H. Townsend will now be Captain of the S.S. "Sybil" and will receive promotion from the date he takes over charge. The Colonial Office have already agreed to Mr. Townsend getting a command vide their despatch No. 255, dated the 26th May 1905.

Mr. E. Waller will become Chief Officer of the S.S. "Winifred" and will draw the pay of the post. The Colonial Office have agreed to his engagement, vide their despatch No. 220, dated the 15th May last; I have the honor to request that you will accord your formal sanction to these promotions when the necessary agreements will be executed.

I am trying to get into communication with Lieut. Wright, R.N. of 4. M. S. "Forte" with a view to offering him the officiating command of S.S. "Winifred" and thereby enable Capt. Farnall to go on leave. On the permanent command of that boat becoming vacant on the launch of our new vessel Lieut. Wright can be offered a permanent command and in the interregnum (if any) can take
