a salary of £4000 a

year and D. Affmann
would be provided
with a furnished house
in this country at the
end of the term. It is

that a list of the
temporary medical
officers now being
selected who may desire

it and who are
are satisfactorily reported
on by the superior
Officers of the Department,
and in that case their
temporary service will
be allowed to count for
