With reference to your telegram of April 11th, Gnoan's health gives no cause for anxiety. I have been obliged to confine him and the other prisoners in a hut on the hill as the medical authorities consider the proper prison insanitary for Europeans. They are therefore ^{really} suffering the degree of discomfort which they deserve and I should be most reluctant to shorten the term of imprisonment. They are visited daily by a Medical Officer.
