large numbers of natives are starving to death in the
Kisumu Province relief works have been commenced con-

Kisumu Town, etc. Probable expenditure £5,000 for
food and supervision will be to a large extent if not
entirely recoverable from this year's Public Works
Vote. Will you sanction expenditure up to this amount
if absolutely necessary.
