No. 65. Your Lordship's telegram of 28th April; funda-

mental latitude and longitude of map of Sotik enclosure  
in my despatch No. 106 are that of bungalow beacon  
Kisumu of the Anglo-German Boundary Commission, viz.,  
latitude 00, 6, 0 62 S; longitude 35 44 41" P.O. E.  
These values refer to Indian spheroid? and they are  
not corrected for Clarke's figure of the earth.  
Data for height gave value to lake level mean between  
Anglo-German Boundary Commission and railway level.  
To reduce to railway levels correction minus 5.5 feet  
must be applied to our heights. Further deduction for  
mean sea level minus six feet making total deduction  
of 11.5 feet from our heights; see Lehren's paper  
Royal Geographical Society.

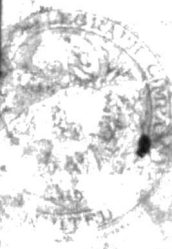
