My Lord,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of  
 Your Lordship's despatch - Miscellaneous - of the 2nd ultimo.

As reported in my telegram No. 99 of the 25th instant

and in view of the fact that it is desirable to defer the establishment  
 of the Legislative Council and I accordingly make arrangements for the Order-in-Council 1906 to be read and  
 proclaimed at the usual hour of the 25th instant. At the  
 same time the proclamation will be made at Government House

in the presence of a number of officials in full uniform  
 and in the presence of the British Consul Officers and  
 the representatives of the Indian, Arab and Swahili  
 communities. After the Order-in-Council has been pro-

claimed, the Commission appointing me to be His Majesty's

Governor and Commander-in-Chief was read and I took the prescribed oaths which were administered by Judge Williams the Guard of Honour presenting arms at the conclusion of the ceremony.

At Nairobi the Order-in-Council was read and proclaimed in front of the War-Commissioner's Office. There were present the officials in uniform, a Guard of Honour and the band of the King's African Rifles and certain of the settlers and residents.

In the morning was short, it being desirable that the Order-in-Council should be proclaimed in both the towns at the same time. The attendance of the unofficial community was not as large as it otherwise would have been.
