21st May. I think it is politic that the South  
African element should be represented on the Legislative  
Council. Captain Cowie is the best selection that I  
can make; he has interests in South Africa and is in  
touch with the South African element though unconnected  
with the recent disturbances. Does Your Lordship  
approve? I have not yet notified my appointments  
to either Council pending the nomination of the  
unofficial members, nor have I spoken to Captain  
Cowie on the subject.
