I have the honour to report that I have caused the arrangements mentioned in your telegram of August 4th to be made in Mr. Doering's lease, and the draft lease has now been signed by that gentleman's representative and manager.

With regard to the references to be furnished by Mr. Doering's bankers, I have the honour to inform you that according to a statement which has been forwarded by the National Bank of South Africa Limited, dated August 17th last, Mr. Doering has a security value of eleven thousand seven hundred and eighty eight pounds, eighteen shillings and three pence, Mr. Doering has a balance in credit at the National Bank of South Africa five hundred and seventy-one pounds, eight shillings and three pence and he possesses other securities.
