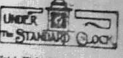
### INTER EMPIRE TRADE

Since the Imperial Conference was held in London two years ago the value of the Dominion and Colonial trade for the manufactured products of British industry has been steadily realized in the Home Country. "Buy British" slogan of British enterprise and in their own way and when their own sphere of influence organizations in the Mother Country are carrying out propaganda as a part of the endeavour to win the war of the future. The British Industries Fair held last year will be a further step in the direction of direct trade between consumer and producer. Even in Kenya we can do something to help. Some days we consider a suggestion that consideration should be given to the possibility of assisting the Home manufacturer in the way of counteracting the purchase of British goods in the Colony. Our manufacturers in the Colony are numerous who manufacture goods made or even wholly made in Home territory. Empire trade deserves additional consideration from the fact that the Dominion and Colonial markets for the fully manufactured goods the East African territories are a case in point. There is in

West, beyond the Empire, as well as proved most consistent by not only the markets for most of the manufacturers of British and the complementary traffic in essential foodstuffs and raw materials for many of these industries. Inter Empire Trade is not a one-sided business.
