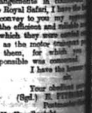

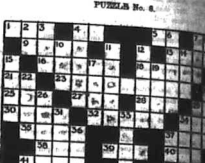
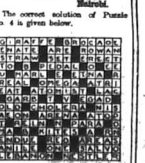

**DEFINITION OF THE TERMS**

In the early days of motoring the phenomenon known as "binking" was not a common word, but with the advent of high compression engines it has become one of the most frequent signs of damage in petrol engines.

Although the terms "binking" and pre-ignition are commonly used and are more or less synonymous, for the demand of a definite explanation but rather for a definite definition of the terms as usually applied to the phenomenon of pre-ignition or "binking" may be produced by excessive rapidity of explosion even when the dose does not occur below the top of the stroke is known.
