The Commission has recommended that the jury system be replaced by a system of judges sitting in a bench of three.

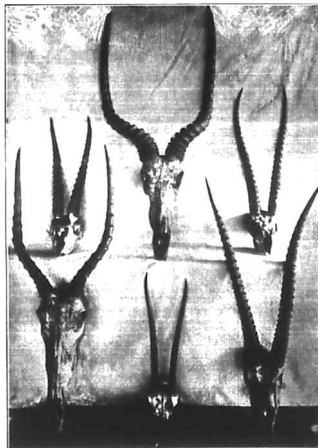

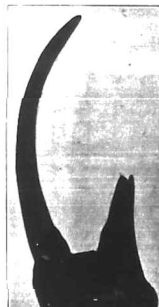

AGRICULTURAL SHOW.

To the Editor. "E.A. Standard." Sir—With reference to the Jumping Competitions which it is proposed will be a great feature at the Agricultural and Horticultural Show which is to be held on July 2nd & 3rd, 1905, at Nairobi.

Seeing that the new Rules of the British Show Jumping Association, to which this Society is affiliated, it has been decided to add two classes to those already published in the Prize List, namely a Gate and Triple Bar, thus making a course of SEVEN jumps.

1. Bush Fence. One of Furze or other suitable material, not more than 4 feet high. A horizontal bar will be placed on the landing side of the fence 9 inches below the top of the fence and 1 foot away from the fence. This bar will be capable of being knocked down and will have a flat metal top, in which bolts will be placed.

2. Gate. 4 feet high. One of the kind known down. Laths will be placed on each side.

3. Wall. 2 feet high. Top 9 inches (if laths) will be capable of being knocked down. Laths will be placed on top.

4. In and Out or Double. 4 feet high.

5. No Jump. Laths will be placed on both lines.

6. No Jump. Laths will be placed on top as a catch point. The Top Bar. All three bars to have laths on top and be capable of being knocked down.

7. Top Bar. 1st Bar 2 ft. 2nd Bar 3 ft. 3rd Bar 4 ft.

Width between bars 2 ft.

This fence counts as one as recent practice.

8. Water. 3 feet fringe in front 3 feet high.

Water 1 foot measured from the fence on each side.

9. Post 4 Balls. 3 feet 6 inches high. The top rail being capable of being knocked down.

10. All above jumps will be 9 feet wide with wings sprung to 15 feet wide.

The Rules for High Jump will be placed at each table.

11. Three trials only will be allowed in each event.

12. The horse which has qualified in one of these trials successfully is eligible to compete at the following trials.

13. The faults are counted at each trial and the classification is made according to the total faults made at each height.

14. The horse which has jumped the greatest height without fault is the best, whether or not he has been the faultless in the previous trial.

15. A "Governing" is the scale of faults.

TROPICAL PRODUCTION

Industrial Struggle.

Mr. John H. Harris, speaking at a Liberal meeting in Manchester on April 12, dealt with the industrial problems of the tropical world, and drew attention to the importance to Europe of the struggle, which was rapidly gathering momentum, for the rights to produce raw material... Mr. Harris pointed out that the world to-day required 450,000 tons of rubber...

PLANTATION SYSTEM

There was increasing evidence, Mr. Harris said, that under white advice the natives were the best and most economic producer, and that the greatest measure of advantage to the white races was to be found in "handing" the raw produce. Plantation systems were inevitably costly, they involved great labour difficulties, and not only led to waste, slums, and the economic success of peasant proprietorship, on the other hand, was now beyond question...

According to the report of the Department of Overseas Trade the native peasant proprietors in Java had smashed the white policy of rubber restriction, and had increased their native exports of raw rubber from 7.7 per cent to 37.9 per cent, with consequent economic advantage to the natives of Java and, incidentally, to the white motor industry in that industrial language, "natives who a year ago had not a rat for their backs can now be seen driving from villages to villages in motor-cars." In the West Indies, sugar estates of Trinidad the abandonment of the plantation system in favour of peasant proprietorship had led to an increase of sugar cane to the mills from 3,500 to 15,000 tons, and an urgent order to British engineers for another sugar mill to cope with the flow of cane.

POTENTIAL COTTON AREAS.

Dealing with the question of the production of cotton in Africa, Mr. Harris pointed out that in Kenya Colony, where the fight was hottest in favour of a plantation system reposing upon a white control of lands coupled with compulsory labour the production of cotton was negligible, whereas past years the bumper in Uganda under peasant proprietorship the natives had in ten years increased their output of raw cotton from 4200 tons to nearly 24,000 tons. Comparing the potential African cotton States with America (Great Britain) had an advantage of a most striking nature, for taking the West African territories alone, there were 20,000,000 acres, with a population of 14,000,000 of people.

If in these figures were added the three cotton-producing territories of West Africa, they gave a combined total of 1,082 million acres, and a population of 34,000,000, as against the American acreage of 420,000,000 with a population of 100,000,000. Was it not extravagant to hope that if America could find 40,000,000 acres of land available for cotton-cultivation within an

LABOUR IN KENYA.

Manchester Comment.

As long ago as February 10 says The Manchester Guardian, Mr. Ormsby Gore, Under Secretary for the Colonies and a member of the East African Commission, presiding in the House of Commons that the report of the Commission on their visit to Kenya would be available to Parliament and the public in a month's time, adding the statement that Lord Southborough's Committee, in whom the Commission were to have reported, stood adjourned.

I have already called attention to the departure in policy indicated by the new Government's virtual suppression of the Southborough Committee appointed by the Labour Colonial Secretary. But even those who hold the Southborough Committee to be superfluous had assumed that, until the Commission despatch to East Africa just before the general election consisting, it will be remembered, of Mr. Ormsby Gore, Major Church, and Mr. Lushington, reported and their report had been debated by the House of Commons, nothing would be done to prejudice the labour question in the colony.

ACTING GOVERNOR'S SPEECH.

The Commission's report is not yet available, and both surprise and resentment have been expressed in political quarters here about the announcement that the Acting Governor of Kenya has already advised the Government policy with regard to the most vital question—namely, the difficulty of finding labourers for the white settler. The Acting Governor has estimated that it is a definite part of the Government's policy that the Administration officials shall assist in procuring labour for the settlers. This departure from a long tradition of British policy will be strongly resisted by members of all parties when the subject comes up for debate in Parliament.

Unfortunately the only member of the East African Commission who remains in the House of Commons is now Minister, Mr. Ormsby Gore, but on the other hand, British politicians in general are remarkably well informed of East African affairs—areas of 500,000,000 acres. Great Britain, could find 10,000,000 more than was needed to produce 3,000,000 bales of cotton within six or seven months. 1,000,000,000 acres, where also could call upon a population of 24,000,000 or 14,000,000 people, is available to the United States?

THE REGISTRATION ORDINANCE.

Lord Leverhulme had recently urged the break-up of our African land systems, in order to permit of a more rapid spread of the plantation system for the purpose of cotton production. This would be a fatal step, for it would smash British cotton enterprise. Experience had shown that in tropical or semi-tropical countries the break-up of native land ownership and the substitution of a plantation system had invariably led to demands for administrative provision in order to obtain labour.

Kenya Colony, for example, had introduced a registration ordinance with sugar-pastor, compulsory labour ordinance, native authority ordinance, and so forth. But even these were inadequate. In the opinion of the settlers, and Kenya was now demanding new forms of Government compulsion in order to force the natives to accept the wage adjustments offered by white settlers—the whole system proving itself entirely infeasible more so, economically. (Manchester Guardian.)

HAIRZ MARKET.

Increased Prices.

Messrs. W. F. Malcolm & Co., reporting to their local agent, A. H. Tod, Nakuru, on April 23 state that there has been a considerable rise in the price of hair during the past week, with a fair trade in carboys and parcels of new crop flax. Also the price of hair has risen during the period of inactivity, has advanced and prices all round show a steady upward movement. Messrs. W. F. Malcolm & Co. have much reduced estimate of the wool plus available for export from the Argentine crop and the prospect of small supplies for the next two months has given fresh encouragement to spot buyers.

Shipments of New Flax Mains were first made about 1/10 on the market, but to-day business has been done by speculators at 37/8 for May/June and 36/5 for July shipment.

South African Mains continue to be firmly held by Shippers as there is little or no prospect of business in the treatment of Flax South African has been sold on 37/8 July/August shipment. The value is 27/1.

Of No. 2 White Flax East Africa, only small quantities are offered. Quotations for the value of No. 1 are 40/6.

E.A. QUESTIONS.

Archbishop of Canterbury.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, says The Yorkshire Post, who is credited with the intention of sitting in the House of Lords although as to the treatment of the natives made in Norman Leys' much discussed book on Kenya Colony has been holding back the publication of the Parliamentary Commission's report, which will interfere deal with the question of the natives and their place in development.

Though it was not in the Commission's terms of reference, federation or at least close association of our territories East and Central Africa is a natural issue. In this connection, however, the immense distances covered by the comparatively sparse white populations, are obstacles to such a scheme.

Other interesting issues are the capabilities of these territories to supply our needs for cotton and other raw material, and their relation to the problem of Empire settlement.
