THE LIGHT SIDEAR.

How to Avoid Unnecessary Stresses.

IMPORTANT POINTS

As the light sidecar No. 6 has proved itself a vehicle of practical utility, articles of general interest, written by E. C. M. J. in Motor Cycling, we shall not doubt see in the near future a greatly increased number of them on the roads, incorporating the 200 c.c. engine, four or four and a half inches, and a torque a measure of low revs will probably be introduced in the form of a heavier, more muscular as the output of 100 to 175 revs. with a two-stroke that a few notes on its general use may not be out of place. For some months past experience has been made with various positions relative to the sidecar and machine in order to settle the problem of the sidecar being on the road, and the writer has come to the conclusion that the best is the light outfit, in which the following may be faithfully observed:

- (1) The wheels of the bicycle must be steady in line.

- (2) The sidecar must be close up, i.e. it must be as near as possible to the 21 1/2 in.
- (3) The bicycle must be least just a shade oversteer, to allow of its being vertical on steeply down-sloping roads.
- (4) The wheel of the sidecar must be at right angles to the sidecar, and not leaning in at all.
- (5) The bicycle must be in the line of the sidecar wheel inwards to correct the oversteer, the bicycle wheels are not in line, and the rider is probably strained. It is better to have more in the sidecar wheel than in the bicycle, but it should not be excessive if the machine is a short wheelbase one, unless a spring swing arm is provided, this is impossible where tread-on legs is incorporated, as one cannot alter the relative position of the two wheels.

The tilt of the sidecar is far more important than most people imagine. To have the peak pointing downwards looks dreadfully uncomfortable for the passenger, besides putting a severe strain on the head of the machine and point of attachment thereto. A raised peak looks all right, but some passengers complain of a feeling that the whole thing may slip up when going down hills.

Personally, the writer prefers the bottom boards to be about level, allows for a slight upward tendency when the passenger is seated.

Regarding the varied question of the use of hand levers, most bikes, options are equally divided. In the former case a machine can be fitted with almost any sidecar on the market, but with the latter one is confined to those limited to that provided by the maker.

DIVING THE STRAIN.

It would be well to see the impossibility of the strain of the machine, as the front arm to both legs, the front axle, and the machine, as in the Triumph, so that each leg has its own weight bearing in the way of the whole being taken by the lower machine.
