## THE FLINT SEAL

Description of the Latest Model.

### A FAST CAR

All told, there are probably no more than a dozen makes of American cars which are "cut-out-bully" class in so far as that special all-through grade of design to which the standard European models belong says as nothing. The others being designed as quantity-production propositions to be made up of stock components in the main, must necessarily be a little short of individuality, though lacking nothing practical, efficient, or otherwise. There is, however, on the contrary, a very special kind of all into the question of how adequate is every detail of its work, and, secondly, what does the whole cost, so that we may see how much actual road value is represented.

**CIVIL AIR SERVICES.**

**Wonderful Strikes Made in Australia.**

**LESSON FOR EAST AFRICA.**

In view of the general dissatisfaction regarding the provisions of the services in East Africa, the following speech delivered recently by Douglas Reid (Speaker, London House of Commons) regarding the services of the Australian Civil Air Service is of particular interest showing as it does, the remarkable amount of work done in the past few years by private enterprise in looking after isolated people in the bush with the service.

Australia is a continent which has been more than any other in the world, the recipient of the services of the communications. It is a land of huge areas, the masses of population live far apart and the terrain and climate are generally speaking everywhere very different. It is a vast continent and when you add to this the fact that the transport can be operated only over the continent without coming into contact with sea water, it is not surprising, owing to the peculiar distribution of the population, it must be obvious to you all that this country is indeed a paradise from the aviation point of view.

From Perth in Western Australia to Sydney in New South Wales, the distance is a straight line just over 4,000 miles. From Melbourne in Victoria, to Port Darwin in the Northern Territory, it is just under 2,000 miles.

In a way which makes it the most favourable conditions for the service plan may play a wonderful part in the solution of the continent. In 1920, Colonel Bransome, an officer of the Australian Imperial Force, was appointed commander of Civil Aviation in Australia and he has developed a plan under the Minister of State for
