Question as to How Long It Will Last.

AN AMERICAN VIEW.

In a recent issue of the *Forbes Magazine*, Mr. Walter C. Reynolds, Technical Editor of the *Automobile Daily News* deals with a question which is often discussed all over the world today. The article itself is too long to publish in full, says the *East African*, but the following extracts will be read with general interest:

He says:
"How long is the present automobile, 'boom' going to last? That is a question that has been asked with increasing frequency since the industry began to show signs of going outward and upward, forever."

With only minor and scattered instances of recession, the entire trend of automobile activity has been a constant programme of increasing production to meet dealers' demands, and then increasing dealers' demands to meet production. This has been a wonderful game, too good to be true or to last."

Common sense seems to indicate that the golden shower cannot continue forever. There must come a time when there will be enough automobiles for everybody. And then, what? Let us see.

THE EARLY DAYS.

From its very beginning a quarter of a century ago, the automotive industry has been outstripping the imaginations of its creators. It has been almost unimagined in the early days, copied was furnished very largely by individuals who were convinced, against what they thought was their better judgment, by an inventor and his friends, that they ought to put money into an enterprise which because of its very nature presented all the hazards of the unknown. The colors of the rainbow that greeted the pioneer are still recent enough to be fresh in our ears. Yet, with comparatively few exceptions, the real pioneers have survived.
One has only to call the roll of

present companies to see that they number many that have been in business since the beginning. There are only a very few recent successes—and these have been achieved against the advice of common sense, or what appeared to be common sense.
The top has become the universal law. One of the pioneers envisioned the widespread use of their invention. Certain men of the pioneers among the manufacturers envisioned the demand for their product would have both factories better adapted to quantity production.
The history of the automotive industry is one of makeshift in manufacturing, of hasty rearrangement of plant facilities to meet a growing demand. Occasional radicals have ventured to look far into the future and to make a coherent plan that functions as a unit. But among even the industrial leaders there were those that saw only too plainly that they have "just grown."

FORESIGHT.

Few things there are that are faster of body rearrangement, or less profitable than preference. The prophet of disaster too frequently finds himself the victim of his own forebodings. If his prophecy of failure is borne out, he is regarded as being somewhat responsible for the condition he predicted; if he forecasts good, he is blamed because his imagination is not very enough.

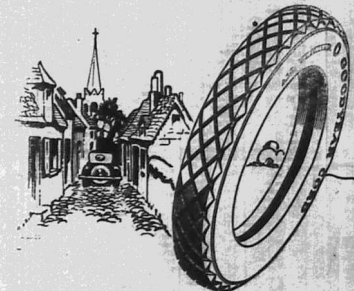

HARVEST OF MILLIONS.

During the last two years the swindlers' harvest in England has been estimated at over £4,000,000. This means they have got for an even richer one. 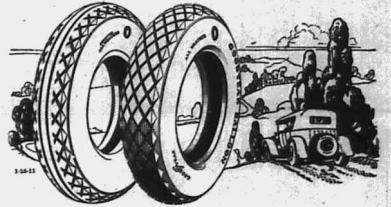

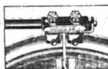
