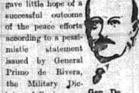

SEVERE CAR TESTS.

Vehicles Defy Mountains in the Andes.

A LITTLE-KNOWN COUNTRY.

Motorists are the tough, hard-riding race of the Andes Mountains in Peru is a severe test for driver and vehicle, but the use of cars is steadily gaining. In this country little known to the average person, improved roads are almost entirely absent. In their stead there are mostly rocky, narrow trails which wind sharply around the mountains with treacherous descents turning on all sides.

It was of this section that Francis Day, of the Peruvian Auto Ltd., Lima, dealer in Dodge Brothers vehicles, who recently visited Detective, told of some of the hardships with which drivers have to contend. The hardships of Dodge Brothers Motor Cars and Graham Brothers Trucks which is necessary to negotiate these hazardous trails, has won for them the admiration of all business men and motorists of the country, said Mr. Day.

Mr. Day told of one road which rises to an altitude of 14,000 feet above sea level and then drops to 4,000 feet in the course of 80 miles. Over this road, he said, 50 per cent of the vehicles and cars and Graham Brothers Trucks.

One asks, how the Peruvians contend travel over these narrow trails when traffic might well go in both directions at the same time. They have devised a quaint system of rules to prevent collisions. Traffic originating in the upper reaches of the Andes, not only on Monday, Thursday and Friday but the lower reaches is allowed to move upward only on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

ROAD BOUNDS.

"The Peruvian Government is also in the need of improved roads," said Mr. Day, "but instead of spending vast sums of money in ancient engineering feats to cut such roads through and around the Andes range, the

officials have been content with opening such trails as will permit travel of most frequent motor vehicle traffic.

At an example of this road, a trail building, Mr. Day said, at the head waters of the Amazon River, high in the Andes range, the Government has begun the cutting of trails from the old roads of Incas. It is the intention, as one of the big plantation rubber estates of the country, that at a point where the road narrows there is no motor vehicle in use in a similar section and that is in Graham Brothers Trucks.

Imported, related Mr. Day, is now a village of but 6,000 inhabitants, but through several of the rubber industry due to increased selling prices, it is becoming a factor again in the commercial life of the country.

A limitation of all weight that may cross the suspension bridges, the only type used, is almost all vehicles. For this reason the Dodge Brothers Vehicles have been found most suitable for the transportation of the natives.

"Peru is rapidly showing the effects of increased capital from the United States. 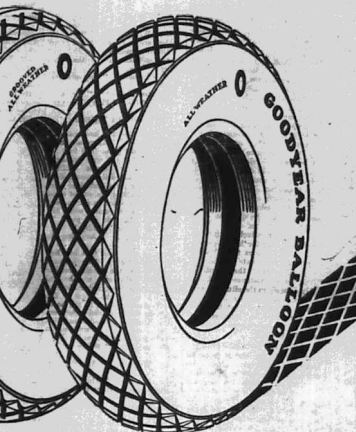

THE PORT CONTROL COMMITTEE REPORT.

The outstanding and most im-
porting feature of the half yearly
report of the Association of East
African Chambers of Commerce,
issued in Mombasa on Saturday,
was the discussion upon the Report
of the Commission on Port Control
issued on the Table of the Legislative
Council during the last session last
year. It is not a subject of discussion by
the Legislature. It is regarded as
unlikely that the Legislative Coun-
cil will meet next month and it is
therefore not probable that the
discussion of the Commission will take
place in Mombasa if Government
decides to hold the next session of
Council at the Cape. There is much
to be gained, despite the inconveni-
ence entailed, from an actively
working of the Council at Mombasa
in most circumstances, including
investigation into port control pro-
blems and the discussion of the
various town planning of Mombasa.

The Commission on Port Control
was set up by the Government in
1927 to inquire into the various
problems connected with the port
of Mombasa. It has since that time
held several public hearings and
has received many suggestions from
the public. Its report is a valuable
contribution to the knowledge of
the port of Mombasa and its
problems. It is a pity that the
Commission's recommendations have
not been fully implemented. It is
hoped that the Government will
take prompt action to carry out
the Commission's recommendations.

MOTURING TOPICS

THE MORRIS CAR

Interesting Details of Output.

REMARKABLE INCREASE.

The extraordinary increase displayed by Mr. W. L. Morris during the 21 years in which the firm of Morris Motors, Ltd., has been in existence has without doubt been due to the engine and chassis design which is the distinguishing feature of the concern, which now stands as Britain's largest car factory.

The fact that it is simply demonstrated for Morris products and the fact that the original basic design has remained unaltered since the evolution in 1913, with the exception of detail alterations and general improvement in appearance. When it is remembered that in 1913 the output of the firm was only 207 cars per year, and that its output has increased to no fewer than 88,712 cars during the year 1932 some idea of the extraordinary expansion of the firm can be obtained.

It must be obvious that a design which will stand the test of so many years is a design which still remains a first favourite must be based on the soundest of fundamental principles and must have been evolved with a foresight distinctly close the ordinary.

TWO TYPES OF CHASSIS. It can be remembered—and an examination of the chassis will prove this—that the design has not in any way been evolved purely as a consideration of appearance in production; indeed, the designer's first thought has been to produce the most versatile car he could devise, and it is therefore all the more remarkable that Mr. Morris has been able to reduce the price of his products to the present extraordinary low figures.

Two types of touring chassis will be mentioned during the run of the present programme, and will be known as the Morris-Cowley and Morris-Endless types as hereinafter.

The Morris-Cowley has an engine with a bore of 80.0 mm., and a stroke of 119 mm., giving an H.P.C. rating of 11.9 H.P., and a cubic capacity of 1,500 c.c. The Morris-Endless on the other hand is of more generous proportions, both with regard to the engine and chassis. Its engine displaces an 8.7 litres, born by 112 mm. diameter,

which gives a cubic capacity of 1,900 c.c., and a B.M.P. rating of 15.9 h.p. The Morris-Endless has a wheelbase of 9 ft. as compared with the 8 ft. 6 in. of the Morris-Cowley, which results in superior economy in the use of fuel.

Both engines are similar in design, having four cylinders of monobloc construction, the cylinders being cast in one with the upper half of the crankcase; side-rod drive with overhead valves, and a detachable head. The engine and chassis are bolted directly to the engine and form an integral unit. The engine and chassis cooling is simply of a water nature of the latest design, and a thermostat valve is introduced in the water system to maintain the cooling water at an even temperature.

Both models have a pneumatic valving steering driven from the chassis, which feeds oil under pressure to the three main bearings the surplus flow which falls into an ingeniously shaped tray in the crankcase sump. The coils of the magnetos are supplied with a pressure which spins into the air the remainder of the working parts with a constant spray of lubricant. A Lucas magnetos is driven through belt gears by a revolute shaft which fits round the engine, which arrange most results in a particularly convenient position for the gas-breaker and distributor.

TRANSMISSION. A Lucas dynamometer driven by silent chain from the motor which supplies the extra-power for engine starting. The three-speed gearbox, which has a centrally disposed gear change and adequate gear locking mechanism, is driven from the engine through a multiple plate, cast steel shaft, and this propeller shaft is totally enclosed in a torque tube, anchored to the rear of the gearbox. This ball joint and the anchor-rod ball joint is automatically lubricated from the gearbox. Spiral level gears are used in the back axle, which has the usual four-rigid differential and axle of the three-quarter tonning type. Four-wheel brakes are fitted to both chassis and are operated by means of the foot brake, the hand-brakes operating upon a pair of independent shoes on the back wheels only. The latest, heavy-duty ball-rod types are fitted to detachable shock absorbers. "W" type rim making type changing, particularly simple operation.

One of the most attractive features of Morris cars is the simplicity of their equipment, especially in type, Gabriel shock absorbers, Lucas dynamometer, lubricating system, top box and ball joint ends, spring fasteners, petrol gas, oilometer (or radiator thermometer), ball-rod type, detachable side curtain, eight-day clock, oil pressure gauge, dashboard light, driving mirror, hand window cranks, heavy-duty horn, petrol can carrier, detachable body, and other accessories. The electrical equipment, Lucas bulb sockets, Lucas battery, Lucas "Shell" spare petrol can, hood bag, and complete and complete for one year for the Cowley types.

The Endless types have in addition thermostatic water control, Barker dipping head-lamps, automatic wind screen wiper, sliding rear wind-screen, Lucas electric horn, rubber's suspension (as enclosed model), and door pockets. The foregoing list clearly demonstrates that no after-purchase expenditure is necessary, the specifications including all fittings which are normally desired.

The Morris range with its lavish equipment, perfectly balanced engine, machine transmission, adequate suspension, and liberal tyre equipment form in every respect the finest of automobiles of its class. With their maximum speed of over 100 miles an hour they should meet the needs of all ordinary road use, and their capacity for maintaining a high average speed makes a strong appeal.

LUCAIS A WEEK.

Although the equality of the Morris factory at Cowley, assisted by its associate factories, is at the present time 1,500 cars per week (or one car every two minutes), Messrs. Morris Motors, Ltd., have found considerable difficulty in keeping pace with the demand for their remarkable cars and have been heavily pressed during the whole of the past season to keep pace with the demand.

The Morris car is produced by the "flow" method, as distinct from the stock production method, the object aimed at being to maintain a steady flow of the required material and parts throughout the works, and keeping each operator in the hands of a highly skilled operator who has made a specialty of this particular work. In this way a high degree of accuracy in workmanship has been obtained and rapid inspection of all incoming material has ensured that only material of the highest quality is incorporated in Morris cars. This rapid inspection and acceptance of

workmanship has resulted in a car of outstanding build and reliability, with a good workmanship and performance which may well be envied by owners of more expensive cars.

It is of interest to note that the popularity of the Morris car is not confined to Great Britain alone, as no less than 300 cars of this model were exported in 1931 to the overseas market, and Messrs. Morris Motors, Ltd., have acquired the franchise for the exportation of future Morris-Lucas motor cars to French territory by the French market.

FACTS AND FIGURES ON PRODUCTION.

THE "Times" New York correspondent, says that the annual production of motor cars in America amounts to 2,900,000 (2,900,000) according to the estimate of the Bureau of Industrial Statistics, which is constituting a national survey of the total of America's 20,000,000 automobiles.

It seems that 400,000 new cars are produced each year. It is supposed that 4,000,000 new cars in the automobile industry are produced each year, including accessories. One direct result of the widespread use of motor-cars is the enormous road-building programme which is now in progress throughout the United States at an estimated yearly cost of \$2,000,000,000. It is also greatly facilitating the rapid expansion of the suburban quarters of the big cities.

The retail value of motor-cars for the current season shows an increase of from 22 to 33 per cent. over the previous season, this largely resulting from the introduction of new methods of purchase by instalment. Some companies now permit of a payment spread over 10 to 18 months, an increase of 32 months previously allowed. The nation's annual expenditure on motor-cars now exceeds the annual value of all farm crops. The value of cars expected in 1932, 1933 and 1934 is estimated at \$2,500,000,000.

CAR TEMPERATURES.

Correct Heat for Oil, Tyres and Other Parts.

HINTS TO OWNERS.

Just as there is a correct temperature for the cooling water, at which the engine will work most efficiently, so there is a correct temperature for a given brand of lubricating oil. In fact, it is of almost equal importance to have the lubricating oil at its best temperature as the circulating water.

The temperature of these two has a connection, for the hotter the cooling water the thinner and less suitable will the oil be. On the other hand, provided the oil circulation is sufficiently assured in other words, provided there is no anti-to-motors contact—the oil will be. The National Physical Laboratory has made tests which show that the oil friction at 212 degrees Fahrenheit is only half what it is at 120 degrees.

LIGHT LOADS WHEN STARTING.

When starting an engine up the oil in the sump is very thick, so much so that it is difficult, even when the pressure pump system of lubrication is employed, for it to get between the surfaces of the bearings. In the circulation and splash system of oiling it is even more difficult.

Remembering this, it will be evident that no reasonable load should be called for when the engine has just started from rest and until the oil has had a chance to heat up. It is during this period of preparation that all the elements of the piston and the cylinder walls that impinge each in the liquid state settle down post the piston into the

semp, and so causes that undesirable condition of which is known as oil dilution.

In many cars which have large and efficient cooling systems it is a long time for the engine to reach its working temperature, especially at low speeds, in the low temperature for the oil. This again points to the importance of a cooling system in which the water circulates in such a manner as to bring it across the thermostat, device or, alternatively, the employment of steam cooling.

In both of these there would be no excess heat on the water until the engine reached its best working temperature, and this would occur in the shortest possible time. On the other hand on overheat engine pumps a thinning of the oil to an extent which may be disastrous, and it is a good practice to keep the outside of the oil in the sump as hot as that some of the heat in the oil may be transferred through the metal. If the engine is cooled with mud this is prevented.

TYRE TEMPERATURES.

When a car is running a certain amount of heat is generated in the tyres. This is due to a number of causes, such as friction with the road surface, the heat of the sun, and a number of other causes. All these help to increase the temperature of the tyre.

It is a well known fact that the wear of the tyre on racing cars is abnormal, and that they do not last very long.

It is not wholly due to the increased friction of the track or road, but in the higher speed, but is also due to the higher temperature of the tyre themselves. Rubber wears and deteriorates much more rapidly at high temperatures than at ordinary temperatures. Owing to this difference of temperature in tyres themselves, due to the variation of surface pressure, speed, load, and road conditions, no attempt has been made to measure their actual temperatures and carry out experiments for wear at these temperatures.

A series of tests have been carried out, however, at varying temperatures, being assumed that the temperature of the tyre increases with the temperature of the air, and the results of these are rather startling.

connections between tyre wear and temperature at a given speed, using the eggs car and low over the same road.

Therefore a series of tests were run at varying air temperatures, and the results with regard to wear were noted. From these it was found that the wear on a tyre when the air temperature is 50 degrees Fahrenheit was twice what it is at 40 degrees, and approaches four times the wear at 60 degrees. This is not to be taken as a guide, for four times the mileage if it was run continually at all air temperatures of 40 degrees as compared with 60 degrees, for there are other factors coming into the question, but it does mean that the wear is considerably greater at the higher temperature, and therefore its mileage obtained will be less.

If the best results are desired from tyre it will be necessary to do everything to keep down their temperature.

People used to laugh at the old-fashioned motorist who served his tyres with a rag when he had to leave his car in the sun, but there was a good deal to be said for him. When parking the car for any length of time it is desirable that a shady place should be found, as this will not only protect the paint-work but also, will make the tyre last longer.

TEMPERATURES IN OTHER PARTS.

With regard to the other parts of the car, although high temperatures have not so much influence they create certain drawbacks.

For example, if the water or the gear box overheats the oil is apt to overheat, and in the case of the former it may get past the packing on to the tyre and also cause the brakes to lose some of their effectiveness. Steam on the piston pack or at the battery, even expansion of the liquid. The amount of fuel lost in the former case may be quite considerable. In the latter case the loss of water in the cells due to evaporation may cause damage to the plates by leaving them uncovered. Paintwork and the upholstery deteriorate when left in the sun or exposed to excessive heat, and even the metal from which the car is made becomes less able to stand up to its work if the temperature is raised through the range of atmospheric temperature the loss of strength is very small. It would therefore seem to be a good idea, on the whole, to keep the car in a cool place whenever possible.—Prof. H. M. Williams in the Cape Times.

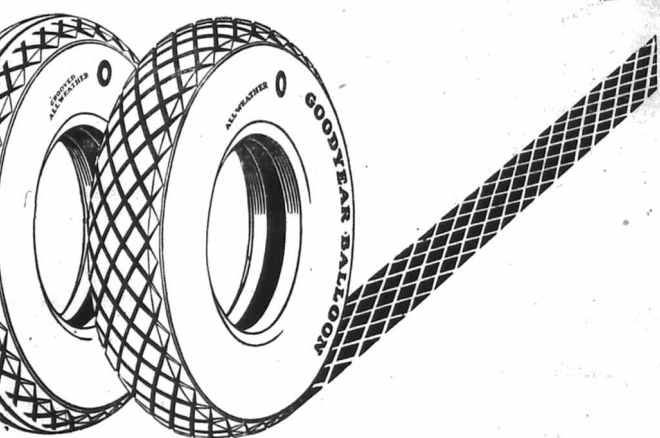

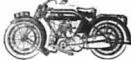

ANOTHER MOMBASA MISUNDERSTANDING.

The difficulty which arose between the Government and the Mombasa District Committee in connection with the discovery that the latter had been deceived by the authorities through the neglect of Government to supply a copy of the Report of the Commission on Electricity at the Port, has been solved by receipt of a letter of apology from the Government and a copy of the Report. The District Committee has returned its sitting and an acknowledgment on the part of the Secretary has been suitably expressed. The world note, before leaving the subject, that the Report was first published in the Mombasa Times and the Legislative Council, and was appended to the minutes of the latter body on March 11th. The Acting Colonial Secretary, in his letter of apology, stated that he gave instructions for a copy of the Report to be sent to Mombasa on April 10th to the District Committee had made a point recently to check before that. This and an apology which was thereupon given to the District Committee was a most welcome possibility, but had allowed an equally long lapse of time before the letter was sent. Unfortunately, a second misunderstanding has arisen since the copies of the minutes and reports have died away. As a result meeting of the District Committee the Port Council, in new place to repeated objections directed to Government, attempted to discuss the problem of ferries. The evidence was not published by the Government. We are pleased to have over before which the official was acting in accordance with special instructions upon his own initiative but the result of the secretive action has been publicity which an ordinary dealer would not have anticipated and has tended to add to the suspicion of the Coast that Government had endeavoured to keep full use of public sympathy and co-operation. We can sympathize with the people of Mombasa, who in the community in the Highlands, they are opinion all at times for the latest information on matters affecting their welfare and they are likely to be angry when they learn that they have been treated as responsible people should not be treated. The interests of the country would have been safeguarded, if they were in any danger, by a statement of the facts at the meeting for the intended procedure and that is the only case in which we would have prevented misunderstanding. Matters of this nature, as a larger public interest, prevent misunderstanding which leave an impression on the public mind, the subject of the Report to be sent to Mombasa has been forgotten. The neglect of the Government in connection with the Mombasa Committee was very clearly apparent. There has been no recent improvement of the Committee has been approved and the Chairman of the Committee has been unable to add anything to the situation. It is to be hoped that the Government will take steps to see that the service was discontinued and were recently necessary have only been avoided by prompt attention rendered by private individuals. There should be prompt attention given. The Port Council Committee is recommended that it should be taken at the earliest possible moment to place the ferries serving the Mombasa Island at a thorough satisfactory basis, both as regards plant and staff and also to report to the Government for transport. More recently the Chairman of the Mombasa Committee stated that the present high charges would have to continue until the service had been placed on a sound footing.
