TO NAIROBI MOTORISTS.

The Nairobi Police Traffic Squad have been instructed as follows—

1. To enforce the existing laws under the Police Ordinance, the Traffic Ordinance, and the Motor Traffic Ordinance, and to pay particular attention to the following points—

A. To allow no parking of cars in the vicinity of the High Court, i.e. Victoria Street nearer backing the High Court, or in the two roads each side of the High Court.

B. To allow no parking in the Avenue (Main Road) from the Railway Crossing to Government Road junction.

C. To allow no cars to remain parked in Government Road or Gardens Street for a period longer than one hour.

D. To allow no double parking of any vehicles in Government Road.

E. To request all motorists parking in Government Road to show up flush with the pavement, and facing the correct traffic way.

F. To warn all motorists who have no rear lights, or who have broken holders inoperably placed that a repetition of this offence will mean prosecution.

G. The instructions as issued above will remain in force for the most referred to, unless objection occurs or complaints are received, when due notice will be given in the papers before any action is entered.

Some necessity at present! The allegory of the raft is, in my opinion, out of place. If European firms are the "rafts" I can understand Mr. Huxford's attitude; the natives are not troubling nor are they likely to trouble much to get on them.

I quite agree that there is ample room for European farms and native reserves in Kenya. I also know that such coffee, tea and sugar are valuable crops, but the natives should be encouraged to produce for the pecuniary benefit of a few thousands of whites. It saves too much of modernisation to hold water in 1920.

When I intended to refer in my previous letter was that arbitrary regulations which would be imposed upon those who would be compelled to work, will not be put through their paces.

The answer to the riddle is—land an economic necessity—or the way to make one. Don't talk of force, compulsion and kindred words; it may merely antagonize the home people and the apprehensive part of the native population here.

But on the hot heads and the sections of settlers whose cry is, "Inverted interests," rights to labour" etc. get down to the brotherly love idea, even if it does hurt your feelings.

I have no data to hand as to the working costs of running a coffee or seed plantation but I will think that if they "must" have large quantities of "cheap native labour" they will experiment labour troubles to such an extent as to make them impracticable. When the settlers grasp the fact that the average native is a capitalist they will then appreciate the fundamentals of the situation.

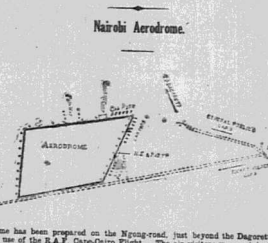

If you have the larvae round
your head to thank you, then
she has deposited her eggs with her
tarsus on the garbage which you
have so thoughtfully provided.
Having done so she flies off to
find the perfect place to lay her
eggs, and relations feeling a
glow of pride in a good deed well
done and not without a sense of
satisfaction that some of the
eggs and larvae of a mother
will ever be here for she knows
that the garbage on which she has
just deposited her eggs will be
the same, sooner, later, and school
to her multitudinous offspring.

Remember that it is the filthy
fact of food feeding flies that in-
fect your body, and think of
all sorts of diseases from a mild
stomach-ache to a fatal typhoid.
Put your garbage in your dust-
bin and out of the house.
Put the lid on to keep the flies
out.
This is the best way to
wipe the inside of your dustbin
occasionally with little emu-
oil, creosol, or similar disinfectant.
Keep your house and compound
clean and your food covered.
