Alienation of Land in Kenya.

SECRETARY OF STATE'S REPLY TO A COMMONS QUESTION

Questions on the alienation of land in Kenya were asked in the House of Commons recently.
Mr. Thorneycroft (Labour, Shrewsbury) asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies the total amount of native land which has been alienated in Kenya Colony during the last three years, and how much of it has been passed into the ownership of one individual?

Mr. Amery (From 1923 onwards the alienations of native land have amounted to 1,430 acres of which 873 acres have been applied to purposes for native benefit such as trading centres, sites for factories dealing with

active products, Government experimental farms and mission lands. Of the rest, 500 acres were required for a township site in a newly administered native area. 110 acres were exchanged for an area of 50 acres of more value to the natives concerned, and with their full approval and four acres were leased for a new mill site. The only instance of the land being sold to an individual was that of the lease of three acres material to an individual, and there is no reason to believe that in any other case has the land subsequently passed to an individual. My information on the subject extends up to August, 1925.

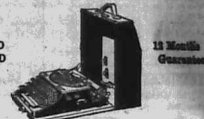

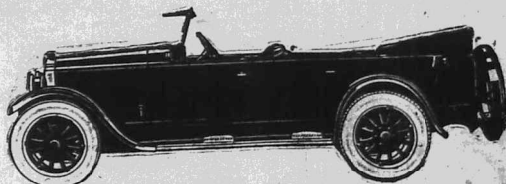

**ASTRONOMER SIX MONTHS
SATURN IN THE UNION.**

Dr. Otto Struve the distinguished German astronomer from Bonn University Observatory near Berlin is at present on duty in the United States, on a study of the planet Saturn from the Union "Saturn." He explained in an interview at the Observatory, where Dr. van der Lee of Leyden Observatory, another visiting astronomer, notes an interesting fact, "has come so far south that we are unable to see it from the northern hemisphere. I have therefore had to follow Saturn. The planet will remain in the southern hemisphere for seven years."

Dr. Struve will remain in Johannesburg for four months and afterwards before leaving to instruct the observatory here on various occasions in order that there will be no loss, as in the past, of the study of Saturn.

Dr. Struve is a member of a family which has had a long connection with the study of astronomy.

An invitation to Dr. Struve to come to South Africa was extended by Dr. Hesse, the Hesse astronomer, who had watched the first dawn to him over a period of 16 years. Saturn having moved Hesse invited Dr. Struve to come to Johannesburg and continue his studies at the Union Observatory.

The invitation was cordially accepted by the Ministry of Education in Germany. That Ministry and also the Ministry of Education considered that it was an excellent opportunity to promote relationship between astronomers in the northern hemisphere and those in the southern hemisphere, and in this way, the advance of science.

Tanganyika Territory to Remain British.

FOREIGN OFFICE DESIRES REPORTED CHANGE OF POLICY

The following extract from East Africa is self explanatory:— "We are glad to hear that the Foreign Secretary's written statement that the British Government has no intention of changing its policy regarding the future of Tanganyika Territory. This confirmation of Mr. Amery's statement at last year's East African dinner is of the greatest importance, and we are very glad to have the privilege of this postulating it. East African opinion is united to make Mr. Wain's words his intention. His letter to the following terms:—

For Sir:—On March 20 I write as follows to the Under-Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs:—

"Colonial Mandate for Germany I lay to require which has been its policy on the part of His Majesty's Government in regard to the political future of Tanganyika Territory since the declaration made by Mr. Amery's Secretary of State for the Colonies at the East African Dinner on June 25, 1924, and subsequently reported in the Press, that Tanganyika Territory was now definitely recognized as being British Empire and would remain so."

"The uncertainty which has been created by these views from the Continent with regard to the future of Tanganyika is not only proving detrimental to the progress of raising further British capital for enterprise in Tanganyika Territory, but is also beginning to have a disturbing effect on existing industry."

"I should, therefore, be glad to have your definite assurance that the British colonial authorities are not only proving detrimental to the progress of raising further British capital for enterprise in Tanganyika Territory, but is also beginning to have a disturbing effect on existing industry."

"I have received in reply the following communication No. (C479) 250, dated April 17, 1925, from the Foreign Office:—

"I reply to your letter of March 20. The Moral Law.

STRANGE STORY IN A P.L.O. COURT.

Scots marriage peculiarities were revealed in Glasgow Sheriff Court in April when the Rev. Archibald Graham Stuart, minister of Eldon Park Church, Govan, was found not guilty of contravening the Marriage (Scotland) Act by performing a marriage with a woman with a previous wife, but without a religious ceremony, but without a certificate of proclamation of banns having been produced.

It was stated that on the evening of February 11 a woman and a young woman with an eighteen-month-old child called at Mr. Stuart's home to seek his advice. They were anxious to marry at once, as the man had to join his ship at midnight.

Earlier in the day they had gone to a solicitor's office to arrange an irregular marriage in the sheriff court, but as they had only one witness the solicitor informed them that the marriage could not take place that day.

Mr. Stuart expressed regret that he could do nothing, as the banns had not been proclaimed.

His wife, however, reminded him that some special provision was made for sailors and soldiers during the war, and suggested that these provisions might still hold good. Mr. Stuart replied that the arrangement had ceased.

A SCOT'S MARRIAGE.
Mrs. Stuart then proposed a Scots marriage. "He went to his study," said Mrs. Stuart "in the witness-box for the sake of the child to take part" and he allowed him and begged him to do this Scots marriage."

Her husband finally agreed, and a simple ceremony took place, only a few words being spoken while the man took a signet ring from his own finger and put it on that of his bride.

Mr. Stuart afterwards offered up a prayer in his study. He had drawn up a document, in which it was stated that the couple had consented to become man and wife, and "in the sight of God and according to Scotland's law are duly married."

This document was signed by the seller and the woman and by Mr. and Mrs. Stuart. It was handed to the witness, but Mr. Stuart advised her that when her husband returned they should have a proper church marriage. This she promised to do.

Mr. Stuart, in a statement which was read in court, said: "I
