ADVISING THE COFFEE INDUSTRY. Why C.P.U. Requires Special Fund. COUNCIL MEETING.

Some interesting papers relating to the future of the Coffee Industry such as the need for a more diversified policy and campaign, were presented at the latest meeting of the Council of the C. P. U. when the Secretary congratulated the members on the subject of advertising a copy of the Kenya Agricultural Supplement of 'The Times' was laid on the table.

The Secretary stated that about 75 per cent of the cost of this arrangement had been recovered in preliminary cash. Mr. Harter called attention to the fact that this advertisement which was to the benefit of the industry as a whole had only been produced possible by the financial services of comparatively few coffee planters and distributors.
It was decided that the question of the formation of an advertisement fund should be discussed at the next General Meeting.

Local advertisement letter from a firm of Shipping Agents, considered the idea of giving free samples of coffee to passenger ships calling at Mombasa. The Secretary was instructed to report that the Union was unable to undertake such a scheme. He then was instructed to recommend the suggestion to local firms dealing in coffee.
A letter from Mr. C. Kenneth Archer, enclosing a letter from the Nairobi Coffee Co. of London, was read. Mr. Archer strongly advised the acceptance of the offer made with the Nairobi Coffee Co. in view of the Union's participation in the 1924 Empire Exhibition.
It was decided that there were not sufficient funds available for this purpose and the Secretary was instructed to cable to that effect.
Mr. Harter called attention to the fact that this was another instance where the absence of an advertisement fund deprived the industry of an excellent opportunity for publicity.

DISEASES AND PESTS. Firstly Pests. A letter on this subject from Mr. Telford was read and discussed. The Secretary was instructed to enquire from the Agricultural Department what steps were being taken in the matter.
Bryden's. The Secretary reported that in the March issue of 'Tropical Life' this pest is quoted as occurring in East and West Africa and Uganda and that he had immediately written to the Editor of that journal pointing out that Kenya was entirely free from this disease and explaining the precautions which the Agricultural Department has taken to prevent its introduction here. The Secretary's action was approved and he was instructed to send a copy of his letter to the Senior Coffee Officer.

POSHO SUPPLY. A letter from the Posho Marketing Association was read; the Secretary also reported that he had discussed this question with the Secretary of the Kenya Farmers Association. The latter expressed the opinion that, until the internal railway route to mastic and cement was opened, individual cotton planters will continue to try and obtain their supplies locally. The Secretary was instructed to try and obtain the help of the aforementioned Association in bringing about such a reduction.

COVER CROPS. A letter from a member, asking that the necessary permission might be obtained for the importation of various seeds from Ceylon, if they are not already available in this country, was read.
Capt. Roper stated that, in his opinion, where there was heavy rainfall certain Strains would give good results.
The Secretary was instructed to consult the Director of Agriculture on this subject and to publish the result of the enquiry for general information.
The Secretary reported that he had made arrangements with the Council representative of an English firm of manufacturers of coffee machinery for special terms of discount to be given by the firm to the Union.

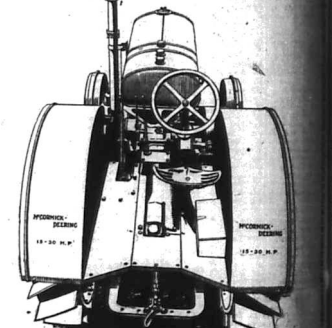
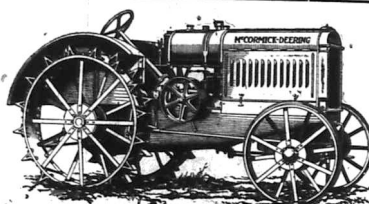

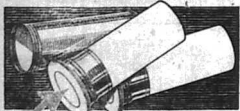

Uganda Plaster's Association.

PROCEEDING AT THE
GENERAL MEETING.

The general meeting of the Uganda Plaster's Association was held recently at Kampala and the following report is taken from the Uganda News.

MR. CAMSON.

The resignation of the President was the next item on the Agenda; but Mr. Camson announced that no consideration would be taken at the conclusion of the other business.

A similar letter was read from the Secretary of the Union of Associations asking if the members of the Association would be willing to pin this new body. After a short discussion Mr. South Smith proposed, and Mr. Bennett seconded, that the Plasterers should join the New Association, but the Union of Associations should remain the Uganda Chamber of Commerce, the Eastern Province Chamber of Commerce, the Clerical Association, and the Plasterers' Association, and that the Indian Association be excluded.

It was announced during the discussion that the King Chamber of Commerce had notified the intention of not becoming a member of the new Union.

Mr. Hill moved an amendment to the effect that the Indian Association be included in the Union. This was seconded by Mr. Joseph, and put to the meeting, which received the support of five of those present.

Mr. Hill's motion was then put "receiving the same" and carried. Mr. Camson in his communication, examined his right, in the use of the casting vote, and voted for the motion, which was declared carried. The accounts for 1922 were passed in read after a short discussion.

FUEL OILS.

Several letters were read in further of a movement which had for its object the reduction of freight and custom charges on fuel oils. In this connection a letter was read from Lord Francis Bute who was a prime mover in the matter and the meeting promised to give the movement their support.

The last item on the Agenda was the Death Ordinance Medical Fees. There was no doubt about the opposition of the meeting to this proposed measure. The Association was dead against it, and moved a strong protest against any such measure being carried out in this country. Mr. South Smith was asked finally to vote for it, but he refused to do so. The President's resignation was then considered. Having explained the reasons for resigning, several attempts were made to

Mr. Camson to reconsider his decision but without success, he resigned the chair.
The chair was then taken by the Vice-President, Mr. Hugh MacFarlane.
Votes of thanks were proposed to the retiring officers for the work they had done for the Association. Messrs. Wetherill and Mowbray were appointed joint secretaries.

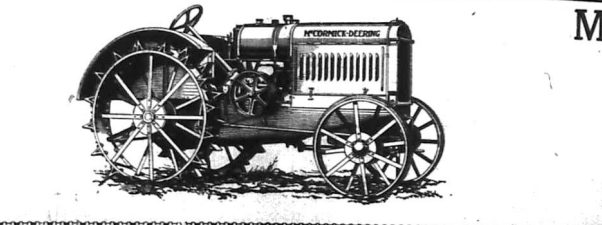
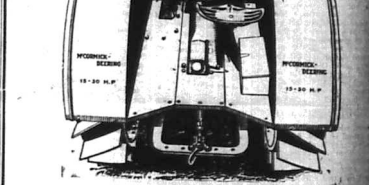

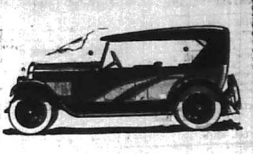

PICTURE REMOVED FROM THE ACADEMY.

At the Request of the Colonial Office.

THE BREAKDOWN.

(From our London Correspondent.)

London, May 11.—The picture entitled "The Breakdown," by Mr. John B. Souter, which was hung in the Royal Academy, and has been much discussed at the request of the Colonial Office. It shows a negro jazz musician sitting on a broken stool in the gutter of a London street, and playing a saxophone. In front of him a single girl, whose modern tendencies are exemplified by her elongated hair, dances to the music.

The Colonial Office took the action because it considered that, inasmuch as we have a large British population containing a vast coloured population in the Colonies, the picture might have objectionable results.

Describing the picture in the course of an "impression" of this year's Academy, our London correspondent says—

A negro in evening dress seated on a broken stool, in playing a saxophone, in a wide girl, who is dancing. The sound of looping rope suspended over by looped mannequins and the ever-deniable light questions are admirably expressed.

THE ARTIST'S EXPLANATION

No one could be more surprised than the artist, Mr. John B. Souter, at the various explanations given to his picture. They are—

"I don't know the solution of "The Breakdown." Perhaps I would describe it as the vitalisation of the negroed soul on an art more than anything else."

It is not mentioned with dancing alone. The latter setting of Minerva typified the breaking down of the Western tradition. It is by no means intended as a satire on the modern art. The title, "The Breakdown," is my own piece of punning. Souter himself, if you turn to your dictionary, you will see that, the "breakdown" is described as a "sudden stoppage, rupture, stoppage, or breakdown, where the dancer makes much noise with her feet." It is not intended to typify the "breakdown" or any of the modern dances. The silk stockings tied round the legs and the rubber pieces of clothing scattered round are meant to emphasize the abandon with which the girl is dancing.

The model for the figure was Maria Lewis, the well-known Chelsea model who this year figures in no fewer than six pictures in the Academy. The negro was Mr. Souter's own creation, painted by some artist of the anthropological section of the Natural History Museum at Kensington. The saxophone he hired from a firm of theatrical outfitting. Mr. Souter is a Scotsman, and had some of the Scotch in him. Although he has travelled much on the Continent he has never worked in foreign studios. The picture has some critics are made about this picture. The Times remarks—

"Mr. Souter's picture is a striking one in the less admirable class of the exhibition."
