London, August 14

Liverpool Shipowners have outlooked all men on the Mersey owing to the refusal of some hundreds to resume work. Twenty to thirty thousand are involved. The position in London is again most grave, thousands of dockers have struck again owing to the dismissal of certain strikers by the Port Authority. A general strike is feared unless an immediate settlement is obtained. Men also are irritated by returning to work while the strike is proceeding in Liverpool.

Fourteen thousand factory girls have struck at Hertsmyth. The railway men of Lancashire and Swinsea favour a national strike. Sections of railwaymen in Scotland also decided to come out. The seriousness of the position has depressed the markets. Sir Thomas Hughes, Chairman of the Licensing bench has been stoned at Liverpool, and is injured in the head. Strikers in the afternoon attacked a breadvan, looted it, and wrecked a public house. The police and Warwicks have dispersed them. Seven thousand dockers have struck at Birkenhead and attacked the police. Reinforcements are being sent.

Detachments of Yorkshire have arrived at Liverpool. A General is in sole command of the City. The magistrates have issued a call of all men between twenty and forty to Volunteer as special constables.

Five thousand cavalry and infantry are under orders at Aldershot for Liverpool. Four hundred troops and one hundred police arrived at Glasgow to-night.

London, August 15

At Liverpool several skirmishes between the police and the strikers occurred yesterday. The military were requisitioned, and the disturbances quelled without much difficulty. Several fires have broken out which it is believed to have been caused by an incendiary. The most serious fire occurred at the offices of the Shipping Federation, which were gutted. During renewal of disorders early this morning the military were called out, and it is reported that firing took place. The papers are already discussing the prospects of a national railway strike. Managers of the principal railway companies met yesterday and decided to fight rather than grant men's demands without arbitration under the Board of Trade conciliation scheme managers declare if there are faults in the working of the scheme they can be easily remedied. The Port of London Authorities have offered to reinstate strikers, provided they agree to being placed on probation for three weeks. "The Liverpool strike committee has declared all transport workers, including railway men are to cease work.

The papers devote many pages in reporting the appearance of a menace of unrest throughout the Country. It is impossible to cable in detail, though it is significant that a number of railway men, mostly of the goods department, have come out at Manchester, Warrington and Shepfield. The following specimens are of the headlines:—"Incendiarism by Mob," "Army Under Arms for Liverpool," "Bain or Bantley," while the Conservatives blame "The Limehouse speech" as having fomented disorder. The "Daily News" fearfully laments the "brutal tactics of police at Liverpool." It appears the troops were called out at Liverpool because the mob was wrecking property. The mob, hiding in the courts, threw bottles at the soldiers, injuring several. The soldiers made a bayonet charge, afterwards firing several volleys. The number of casualties are at present unknown. Sixty-six men have been arrested.




