MOTURING TOPICS

CAR PRESERVATION.

How to Retain the New Appearance.

FIGHTING DEPRECIATION.

Appearance may be said to influence the buyer of a second-hand car more than any other factor. If a prospective buyer takes the look of any car he sees generally past over one or two minor defects in its condition, but if he is put off by a shabby, tired worn appearance he is not likely to waste time examining it in a mechanical fashion.

Further, the owner of a new car wants to be able to sell it easily when he wishes to change to a more modern model and will take care to preserve the new appearance as long as possible.

Comparatively few motorists realize how the use of a good polish not only prevents the oxidation of metal and dirt, but also makes cleaning easier. Before polishing it is well to rub the car over thoroughly with a suitable cleaner to remove dust particles that may be on it which may persist even if the car is afterwards fully washed with water in the ordinary fashion.

POLISHES THAT CLEAN.

Certain special car waxes are cleaners also, and the mere effect of rubbing them in puts foam over the painted surfaces, erases stains and mudds and imparts a beautiful lustre. Obviously they hold dirt and grime off and keep the car looking like new. Some of them are also good for the metal underneath the paint.

The leather upholstery treated in the same way will also be cleaned and polished. A car that is thoroughly cleaned and polished will not only look better, but will also be better protected against the effects of the sun, rain and other elements of the weather.

THE HOOD.

Often the car has been well kept and the body in good-looking shape

and it is for the fact that its appearance is spoiled by a shabby hood. This article, if of the material, can be painted over with suitable body paint when it will be considerably ornamented and any tendency for it to become rancid will be through rain will be frustrated.

Canvas hoods may be treated in a similar manner, but it has to be pointed out that they are not quite the same appearance as previously. In some cases a light grey or blue-colored canvas hood can be substituted very cheaply, but it is to be feared that the application of such a material with the usual oil-soluble substances affect the painting afterwards. The hood is not as light as the canvas, but it is still sufficient, though, to be a little different than previously.

British Motor Trade.

DISAPPOINTING FIGURES FOR APRIL.

The feature of primary importance in the April Board of Trade Returns is the slump in the exports of British motor vehicles and accessories. The figures for the reporting period, the figures for April are somewhat disappointing since the Motor.

To show the extent of the slump, we may say that in March the volume of export business of motor vehicles was represented by a value of £215,702, and it was valued in April that the million more would be reached. Instead of this, however, the value has fallen to £203,248, a decline of £12,454.

Comparing the April values for this year with those of the corresponding month of 1924, there was a drop of £100,882, and in the year ending in this 1925, compared with the same period of 1924, there was an increase of £208,124, but a comparison of the returns for the month of April 1925, shows a falling off of £40,212, or there was a decrease of value of the imports of motor vehicles and accessories for the month of April, 1925, compared with last April, an increase of a million—actually £277,984.

An analysis of export and import values shows that the increase in the value of motor vehicle imports exceeded those of exports of £28,523, while for the four months' export values exceeded their excess over imports by £127,702. In the March returns the last we have had for some time—export values for the month exceeded imports by £2,284, and for the three months' export values were in excess of imports by £207,215.

TYRE TRADE.

Turning to tyre exports we find a decrease of £21,182 in April, compared with March, but it is not so much as it might be expected with the same month of 1924. For the full four months' export values have advanced by £220,426 over the corresponding period of 1924. Both in the case of the April figures and those for the four months the export values exceed those of imports—April by £20,721 and during the four months by £254,477.

Tyre imports fell by £430,205 in April, compared with March and 1924, while there was an increase over 1923 of £215,702 for the four months of 1925.

PETROL.

British petroleum is being exported in much smaller quantities in 1925 than in 1924, and the decrease in the four months being £2,938,929 gallons.

Petrol imports suffered a similar decline in April, compared with March, £2,977,746 fewer gallons being imported. Compared with April 1924, there was a drop of the four months of this year, compared with the same period of 1924, an increase of 11,555,390 gallons is shown.

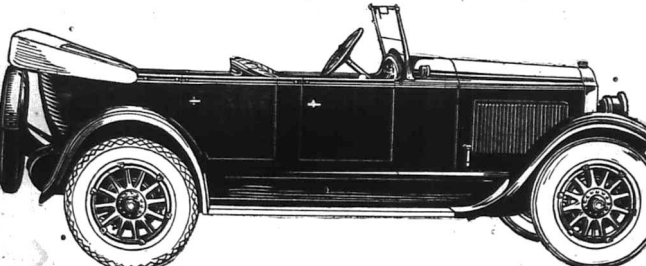

NAIROBI BRAND ROAD.

Report on Journey Through Tanganyika.

A DIFFICULT TRIP.

In view of the forthcoming Livingstonia Conference, which will probably be visited by numerous Kenya residents, sport from the normal delegation, the following information, supplied by a motorist who has just returned from Tanganyika may be of interest to the Conference visitors to the Continent.

ROADS.

Undoubtedly the worst part of the journey is from Nairobi to Londolozi, which should be made the first stopping place as there is now a Customs House for Tanganyika Territory, 12 1/2 miles from Londolozi to Arusha, the next two hundred miles you strike the Volcanic Ash, when it becomes extremely difficult.

The second day's trip should be to Mgoowe in the Usambara Mountains, where there is an excellent camp and no fear of questions. Sufficient petrol should be bought at Arusha 18/1, for a gal. tin to be carried to Mgoowe (240 miles) where it can be obtained for 20/1 a gallon. There is a bad stretch of very rough road about 20 miles in length, 154 miles.

Third Day: Mgoowe to Dodoma (155 miles), which is the stopping of about 12 miles, quite a good road 102 miles.

Fourth Day: Dodoma to Iringa. Until you strike the foothills and Iringa the road is excellent—102 miles.

Fifth Day: Iringa to Beahli (155 miles), where there is a good camp but it is not recommended to strike to sleep in the bush, as such inland roads can be bought at Arusha, Dodoma and Iringa.

The filtering unit itself consists of 60 small zinc granular rings. One side of each ring bears a number of concentric ridges which the rings are stamped together the projections prevent an amount of dirt in effect, they are a top of a few thousands of an inch in width between adjacent rings.

The ridges pass unobstructed through these gaps, but all impurities, it is claimed are trapped, and fall to the base of the glass containing liquid. Thus the motorist can satisfy himself by a glance at the level when it is time to clean out the filter.

Probably the most effective way of cleaning the plates, would be to wash the cage complete in paraffin.

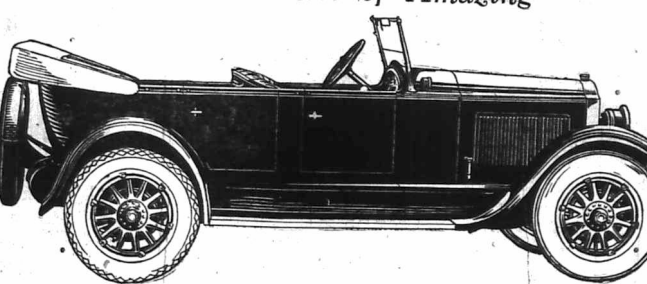

TOW.

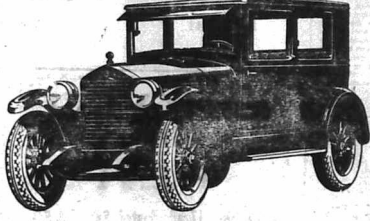
