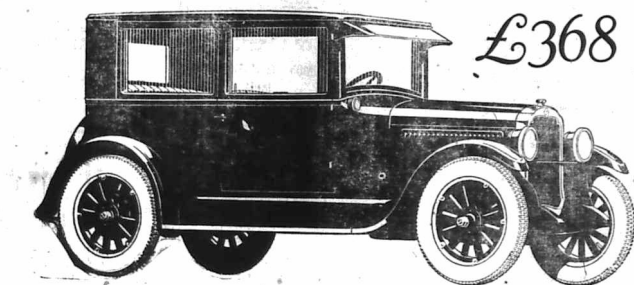

UGANDA'S FINANCIAL POSITION.

A Review by the Governor.

NEED FOR CAUTION.

Shortly before visiting Uganda the Governor Mr. Vinton Collins received the Protector's financial position which has obtained an encouraging factory there were, however, certain factors to be borne in mind which indicated the necessity for care and caution.

Continuing Mr. Vinton Collins said: "The excess of receipts over liabilities, of, in other words, net surplus balance, for the year 1925, £292,928 on the 31st December, 1925, but at the end of 1924, had increased to £1,183,876, a considerable increase of £1,000,000 during the year 1925 being accounted for by a revenue of £1,479,284 against an expenditure of £1,108,806. The estimated revenue and expenditure for the year 1926 were £1,184,927 and £1,120,102 respectively. The revenue, therefore, exceeded the estimates by £294,327, while the same year expenditure was only short by £417,706.

The revenue for 1925 as compared with 1924 shows an increase of £229,494, which is an eloquent testimony to Uganda's continued prosperity.

The expenditure compared for the same period shows an increase of only £186,734. (One feature deserving special mention is that very little surplus balance is locked up as out of the surplus of £1,183,876 on the 31st December, 1925, no less than £1,025,500 was held in cash, and really realizable investments.

An analysis of the Revenue of 1925 indicates that all the revenue shows increase, over the 1924 collections, whilst estimates for 1925 are exceeded in every instance. The principal increase appears in Customs, the receipts for 1925 exceeding those of 1924 by £26,265, while the original estimate for 1925 is exceeded by no less than £103,419 against an original estimate of £350,000. Uganda's share of the total imports, into East Africa, worked out at 43 per cent. in 1925 against 40.64 per cent. in

1924, which clearly indicates that the country's prosperity is being maintained.

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS.

The value of the exports and imports for the last two years are—
EXPORTS: 1924 £3,667,800, 1925 £3,432,111.
The imports for the same year are—
1924 £2,044,222 and £2,077,704, respectively, a total for the two years of £4,121,926.

In considering these figures as exports and imports, which are in the line of their appearance, a continuous margin of excess of exports over imports, one or two factors should be borne in mind which are not obvious from the public statistics.

In the first place it must be remembered that the exports are reckoned as at the Port of Export, and of course, include all expenses which have been made for railway freight and other charges of production. The imports are valued on including cost, insurance and freight at Mombasa. Before we can arrive at the actual cost of these imports in the purchase or cost price in Uganda, we must, of course, add to the value at the Port the cost of railway freight and Customs duties. If these are taken into the value included in Uganda of the imports of the past two years amounts to a total of approximately, £1 million.

There appears to be, as might be expected, a very close relation between the amount paid our every year to the producers of cotton and the value of imports into Uganda. I will allude to this later on in considering the prospects of the cotton industry for 1926.

COTTON: A BEHEMOTH TOTAL.

The value of the cotton export of 1925, very nearly the record total of £4,685,002, an increase of very nearly two million over the previous year.

In 1925 Customs and Excise represented 94 per cent. of the total value of the exports, in 1924 it was 92 per cent. It will be clear to you, therefore, that our present position in being dependent on the single crop has not undergone any considerable modification.

The two other principal sources of revenue are the Cotton Tax and the Poll Tax.
The revenue for 1925, on the basis of the Cotton crop of 180,000 bales, was estimated at £1,210,000, that is to say, approximately, and the crop was 180,800

bales, a remarkably close estimate. As compared with 1924, the Cotton Tax for 1925 shows an increase of £26,775, or approximately 18 per cent.

The receipts from Poll Tax amounted in 1925 to £410,000, an increase of £20,775 over 1924, representing an increase of 5.12 per cent. Practically all the collections on exports are accounted for by Revenue of 1925 exceeded the collections in 1924, although comparatively small additions to the total account for a considerable increase in revenue.

POSTS AND TELEGRAPHS.

The keen desiring official comment to the receipts from the Posts and Telegraphs. As no doubt you are aware, a fresh agreement was entered into between the Governments of Kenya and Uganda Office from the 1st January 1925, regarding the working of the Post Office and paying Uganda an estimated lump sum contribution. The arrangement did not work satisfactorily, and the revised agreement in more or less, on the lines of the Customs, in so far as Uganda receives her full postal receipts and pays a percentage amount of the expenditure.

Financially, the result has been satisfactory as from the deficit of £1,100 in 1924, we have received a surplus of £630 in 1925 (do not), in addition to the surplus postal business which has resulted from the general trade extension.

The saving of £117,700 on the sanctioned expenditure for 1925 is mainly attributable to a saving of £90,487 in Public Works, Extraordinary. The original programme for 1925 amounted to £228,000. But for a variety of reasons it was found impossible to carry out all the works which were projected.

REVENUE PROSPECTS.

To deal now with the Revenue prospects for 1926 I can at this early date only offer comments on various Customs, Cotton Tax, and at 19th April, 1926, with those at the same date 1925, and draw a few inferences.
For Customs the figures are £1,414,141 compared with £1,184,927 in the corresponding period of 1925, a proportion of 119.8 per cent. for this year being taken on the basis of comparison.

Cotton Tax has produced £52,873, as against £48,500 for the corresponding period last year.



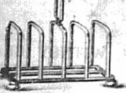

FRANCE'S GRAVEST HOUR SINCE THE WAR.

Ever-increasing Financial Difficulties.

How an Author Attracted Attention.

(FROM OUR PARIS CORRESPONDENT)

Paris, June 11. Last week I intimated that M. Raoul Furet, the Minister of Finance, was rapidly approaching the end of his tether. His calm optimism, which in the beginning had impressed and reassured the country, began to waver impatient criticism some time ago, and his fits of pique to the level of force. This week the situation went further afield from him to worse. Despite the proclamation of the Cabinet that it had never been more homogeneous, never more united, despite its readiness to adopt all the measures recommended by M. Tardieu, this beautiful country did not suffice to arrest the fall of the franc, which tumbled more and more rapidly on Monday and Tuesday.

Evidently M. Furet felt he was no longer master of the situation; that the remedies he proposed were wholly inadequate. And he resigned forthwith. At the time of writing, this is understood to be the gravest hour France has known since the Great War. Our currency is still establishing new depreciation records. It is obvious that we must act rapidly and with energy. Meanwhile the whole country is wondering when the "perfidie" will really slipping down the fatal slope, or whether at last it will probably be capable of saving her from herself.

VILLE DE PARIS BUDGET.

One of the first effects of the exchange fluctuations is a big deficit in the Ville de Paris budget. Today it is a bagatelle of a hundred and fifty million francs! In the present state of moribundity, who knows but that tomorrow it will be a matter of two hundred million or more? However that may be, it is very evident that a considerable sum will have to be

found to stop up this gap, and the Parisian is hourly expecting the inevitable increase in the cost of all municipal services: water, gas, electricity, and so forth. But in these hectic times the municipal authorities are accepting it all with a facility of attempting to save, on the modest scale, under existing conditions, but from day to day. When he must pay, he does so with a shrug of the shoulder; a characteristic gesture that for the Parisian is full of unostentatious and unostentatious significance.

POLITICAL TABOO.

It is clear that our younger generation has no use for politics. And the more too pronounced its intention in this direction, the more it manifests proportionately its enthusiasm for sport. Every Sunday in France is now a great sporting gala day. Last Sunday at Chantilly, it was the Jockey Club arena, frequently called the "French Derby." At the Stade de Colombes there was a big football match between the French and Yugo-Slavian teams. League champions visited the final test of the cycling championship organized by a prominent French newspaper. And there are only two or three of the outstanding events of the day. Throughout almost the whole of France, despite a driving rain, enormous crowds gathered their spirits undampened by the deluge poured almost incessantly from لندن skies.

SARAH BERNHARDT MEMORIAL.

Visitors to Paris can scarcely fail to be disappointed in the memorial unveiled last Saturday, on the Place Madeleine, to the memory of Sarah. She is represented in a passive attitude, in the rôle of Phedre, one of the most brilliant of her triumphs in the classic school. But the figure dates back to a first too remote to be justifiable that magnificent histrionic efficiency, or to the more progressive who in our modern day. This is not the triumph of the lady and still more connecting epoch that makes her wondrous and strange the fall flowering of her genius would have been a happier inspiration—that Sarah Bernhardt might have smiled upon. There is nothing of sculptured psychology in the statue on the Place Madeleine. It is just a picture in stone that has in no sense captured the dynamic aura of an epoch.

THE PUBLICITY FETTER.

We have long held a superstition, and have deserved it—long conspicuous lack of enterprise in the conduct of our business affairs. But it would seem that our nation's attitude is in the course of transformation. Money Philippe Colerier, a middle-aged school of city shrew, has just completed a formidable work on the "Doctrine of Evolution," a small, very money-wise, yet serious study pursued under conditions of the most abject poverty. Colerier is proud of his work. He is convinced that the new ideas it embodies may do much to alleviate the lot of suffering humanity. But also, he was only too well aware of the financial difficulties that beset the public who essay to persuade the stony-hearted tribe of publishers that genius is knocking at their door. What could he do to attract it in a more efficacious manner the attitude of the Great Public? Philippe Colerier decided that suicide was the easy way. He bought a revolver, fixed it resolutely against his temple, fired five times and by a miracle, still lives! Doubtless M. Colerier will find publishers better disposed when he comes out of hospital. One sincerely hopes so, for whatever may be the merits of his book he has, at least, invented a means to speed up our somewhat slow-moving methods of natural evolution. In any case, he deserves renown as a twentieth-century Mose; and a fortune as a business man.

TELEPHONE AMESITIES.

The most recent invention of the telephone administration is an automatic talking machine. Since certain new exchanges have been erected, it has been found necessary to change the numbers of a great many subscribers. When the old numbers are asked for it is the mission of the automatic machine to reply that the number has been altered, and to request the caller to consult the telephone directory. It is a sad but that the inattentive subscriber will find the innumerable chain of the mechanical contrivance even more irritating than the voice of Miss Telephone. So doubtful it will be a good lesson in senior falsetto. There is little fun to be had in installing a machine in a moment of forgetfulness. The subscriber would scarcely survive so devastatingly ridiculous a situation.
