French Food Riots.

WOMEN RAIDING MARKETS.

ATTEMPT AT LYCHING.

FARMS SACKED.

(Brewer's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

Paris, August 20. The high prices of food has led to rioting in the north of France. Bands of women are raiding the markets and seizing the produce. A crowd attempted to lynch a baker who used a revolver in defending his shop. The gendarmes rescued him in the nick of time.

Paris, Aug. 31. The dear food demonstrations are spreading, and serious riots have occurred at Valenciennes, Liège and Reims. The Markets are closed and there is sabotage everywhere.

Brussels, Sept. 1. The dear food riots have spread to Belgium. Three thousand women at Haantwerp demonstrated against milkmen and bakers who escaped in motor cars.

Paris, Sept. 2. The dear food disturbances are becoming more serious. A barricade has been thrown up at St. Quentin to oppose the advance of the "pated." Cavalry charges have been made at different places. Bands of women are ransacking the country, ransacking farm houses. An official now declares that the disturbances are degenerating into an insurrection movement and are spreading with a character which is rather revolutionary than economic, but the Government is determined to ensure order.

More Mystery Ships.

Fitted to Carry Guns.

London, Aug. 30. It is reported to-day that the customs officials have detained six more ships which are suspected of preparing to carry ammunition in being fitted to carry 47 gun sections of which labelled pumps have been seized. There is a growing belief that these are connected with Portuguese counter revolution which is financed on a most lavish scale. On the other hand it is affirmed in other quarters that although many Portuguese royalists have recently arrived in England the square is not connected with Portugal but with a water way in South America.

London, Sept. 1. From information received from an authentic source it is learned that the mystery ships are destined for a South American expedition of a powerful nature, but the confusion arose in mistake. Bahia Blanca in Argentina, to which the vessels are bound, with Bahia in Brazil where it is believed there are many Portuguese royalists.

Newfoundland Fires.

VILLAGES DESTROYED.

St. Johns, Aug. 30. Forest fires are devastating the north-western portion of Newfoundland; villages are being destroyed, communications interrupted and the inhabitants are fleeing to the seacoast. The Government is dispatching a relief steamer.

LATER.—The Newfoundland fires are under control and the damage is less serious than was at first believed.
