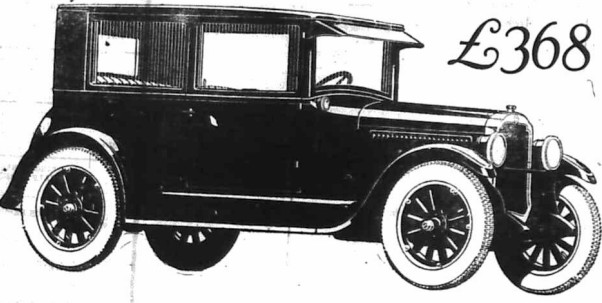

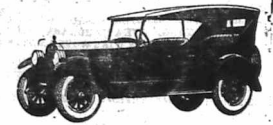

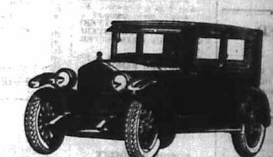

NEW CAR ADJUSTMENTS.

Vital Adjustments after First 1000 Miles.

WHAT TO DO

(Continued from yesterday.) We can now turn to the transmission system, and, taking first of the clutch. No adjustment may be required here, unless the lining has bedded down to an extent making adjustment to the pedal position necessary. It is more opportune, however, or sooner at all times the importance of adjusting the spring bearing, i.e. the bearing connected to the flywheel which carries the forward end of the clutch shaft, and the clutch adjustment mechanism. These points are often overlooked, but should not be.

So far as the gearbox and back axle are concerned, it will probably be safe enough for the owner to go on without himself with making any, but the oil level is adequately maintained, draining and refilling can safely be left until two thousand miles or so have been covered. Incidentally, when these operations become necessary they should be carried out just after the car has come in from a lengthy run, when the warmth of the gearbox and back axle will make the oil thinner and more manageable than is usually the case.

GEARBOX AND AXLE LUBRICANTS.

One low and back-axle lubricants are so thick that in a matter of some difficulty to make sure that the correct level is being obtained. Indeed, in the case of the gearbox, it is often the quickest way to remove the oil entirely. Overfilling is serious.

When attending to the transmission it will be as well to make sure that the universal joints are thoroughly greased, also the parts of which the back axle is built-up.

The brake gear can now be looked at, the most thing being to ensure that, while everything is working freely, no part is doing any slack. Furthermore, during the initial running period, the things may have bedded down to a certain extent, so that they are

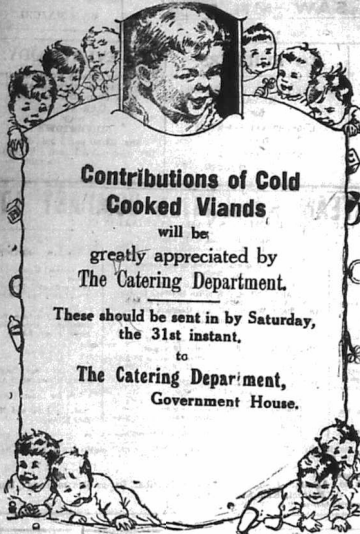

THE WAR AGAINST DISEASE

Prompt Measures to Stamp out Plague.

NAIROBI STATISTICS

Expansive Destruction of Nests.

The Report of the Medical Officer for Nairobi and 90 in the Nairobi district, as submitted with 57 cases from both areas in 1924.

ANTHRAX

59 cases were reported of which 6 occurred in Nairobi and 90 in the Nairobi district, as submitted with 57 cases from both areas in 1924.

With the exception of six outbreaks of the disease, accounting for 44 cases, which occurred more or less simultaneously in different parts of the Nairobi district during May, the other cases were distributed fairly evenly throughout the year.

HERN BERN. 5 cases of this disease were notified, both of which occurred in Nairobi. Both the cases were African and both recovered. In one case the disease was acquired in Nairobi. No information could be obtained in regard to the other case as it was not notified until nearly a year after it had occurred.

CIEKIBO SPINAL FEVER. 17 cases were notified during the year as compared with 14

cases in 1924. 8 of the cases occurred in Nairobi and 9 in the adjoining districts. Of the total cases, 16 were African and 12 were European, and 8 of them were known to have proved fatal. Nothing in the nature of an epidemic occurred, all the cases being sporadic. Although our knowledge of this disease is still somewhat obscure, the organisms responsible for the disease is known; an organism which is found not only in those animals by the disease, but which is also found in the soil and in the air. The disease is also associated with cleanliness and ventilation. Conditions in Nairobi would appear to be ideal for the spread of the disease and suitable epidemic conditions.

DIPHTHERIA

This disease, which was reported in Kenya for the first time in 1924, so far has shown little tendency to become prevalent. During the year only 2 cases were reported as compared with 11 in the previous year. One case occurred in Nairobi and the other in the Nairobi district. The Nairobi case, which was notified in January, was a European nurse who had been attending one of the cases of Diphtheria which occurred towards the end of 1924. The other case, a European child, developed the disease on a farm near Nakuru, and the source of infection could not be traced.

LEPROSY. During the year 19 cases of Leprosy were reported, 9 from Nairobi and 10 from the adjoining districts, as compared with 10 cases from both areas in 1924. The cases, which with the exception of one in Nairobi, were African, were submitted to the Infectious Diseases Hospital where 3 died. The disease does not appear to be very prevalent in this part of the Colony, but no reliable information as to its incidence is available.

Treatment was again carried out on the lines described in our Annual Report of 1924. With the exception of one case shown on pages of a microscope of the disease for a period of approximately six to eight months, and while others have derived considerable benefit from the treatment, the results of treatment on the whole during the year have been somewhat disappointing.

Many of the cases, however, were in a fairly advanced stage of the disease and had they been admitted into hospital at an earlier date more encouraging results might have been obtained.

In chronic diseases such as Leprosy, the manifestations of which may remain latent for a long period, courses of treatment spread over several years are necessarily necessary. Unfortunately, when the course of the disease has advanced to an extremely difficult to interrupt, the relative economy of prolonged treatment is not to be overlooked. It is therefore a matter of considerable importance to the patient and his family the possibility of improved facilities should be seriously considered.

MAITA PEVER

6 cases of this disease were notified in Nairobi and 9 in the adjoining districts. No information is available in regard to the source of infection was obtainable in any of the cases. The disease was first recorded in the Colony in 1920 and in the interval does not appear to have spread to any extent.

MEASLES

17 cases of Measles were notified, all of which occurred in Nairobi. The disease, which chiefly affected African adults has not been prevalent during the year. The cases were generally of a mild type, but one death was recorded.

PLAGUE

49 cases of Plague were reported, of which 9 occurred in Nairobi and 40 in the Nairobi and Nairobi districts, as compared with 58 cases from both areas in 1924. 57 of the cases proved fatal, which is equivalent to a case mortality of 75.5 per cent. In Nairobi the first case occurred in May, an adult male African, who had been imported to the disease being found dead near the Municipal depot. No information could be obtained as to how or where the infection had been acquired. In June a second case was recorded, a male African child who had arrived from Nairobi two days previously, being found dead at the Railway Station. A post mortem examination revealed the fact that he had died of Plague. A third case was reported in Nairobi, a male African adult being found dead at the Railway Station in a train which had arrived from Nairobi, his death proving to be due to Plague. Another case occurred in September, another male African adult being discovered dead at the Railway Station in a train from Nakuru, death again being caused by Plague.

The virus, precautions to prevent the spread of the disease were observed in accordance with the instructions of the four cases gave rise to a (Continued on page 9).


