MOTING TOPICS

THE BEAN "TWELVE"

A Well-Tried British Made Car.

A ROAD PERFORMANCE.

Writing and sturdiness are adjectives which seem particularly suited to a family car, irrespective of its size, make, and cost. It is a family car, and comes a four-wheeler, four-cylinder engine with 12 h.p. beam. It is an excellent piece of equipment of a practical kind which the owner is likely to need. Says a driver in the Motorist.

To a driver on the street the general aspect of the car is the fact that it is particularly easy to handle, for the steering is light and yet definite, the car holds the road well and needs no special care over bad surfaces, and the brakes, both the four wheel set-up and the special rear wheel brake set-up by lever, are as effective as they are to suggest immediate mastery over the car. Then there is a feeling also that the car will go well where without difficulty.

WELL PLANNED GEAR.

The Bean Twelve has a four-speed gear box with a third gear which enables most main-road hills to be tackled fast, a second gear that enables for twisting hills that are to be tackled fast, and a bottom gear which may be regarded as necessary only for emergency purposes.

Because the wheel front axle is adjustable, the steering wheel is correctly positioned, and the brakes change-over, and so far forward in the driving compartment, the driving position can be made to suit people of widely varying height.

For starting purposes on the level, second gear can reasonably be used, the actual operation of gear change requires no special skill, but the extreme of a little judgment. Changing up is best performed easily, and with only a slight pause if the double-clutching method is used. Changing down responds to the normal double-clutching, but as the top gear does not shift as easily, it pays to hit the accelerator pedal and when the accelerator is depressed the driver and accelerator to be unshaken lightly prior to completing the second wave.

ACCCELERATION IS GOOD.

Acceleration is good, and there is no difficulty in starting on a hill. Measured by the stop watch, the car takes about 12 1/2 seconds to accelerate from 10 to 30 m.p.h., and about 10 seconds to reach 40 m.p.h. By 30 m.p.h. the maximum speed is reached, and on a hill of 20 m.p.h. on third 80 m.p.h., and on level 90 m.p.h.

ENGINE AND SUSPENSION.

The side-valve engine is remarkably smooth and quiet. There is a certain amount of vibration at about 30 m.p.h., but nothing objectionable. For sloping along when coasting, at steady 20 m.p.h., appears to be a good cruising speed, and at 30 m.p.h. the car runs particularly quietly. With only 100 miles or so to its credit, the car which we tried was still a trifle on the stiff side, and things had not run themselves in.

Tried from 40 m.p.h. on a level road, we found that the car could be brought to rest with the Ford type four wheel brakes in 100 to 150 ft. It could also be brought to a dead stop from 20 m.p.h. without a great deal of 1 in 10, when very good progress was being made on the road. The side valve would slow down the car to rest on the same gradient. Both sets of brakes were smooth.

Semi-elliptic springs, fitted by the way with spring guides and Smith shock-absorbers, are used for the suspension. They give good insulation from road shock; indeed, but surfaces have to be really bad before their presence is noted. We found with two people on board a tendency towards leaning, but this was considerably lessened by tightening up the shock-absorbers.

Included in our Warwickshire road trial is a fair selection of hills, and from the performance of the Bean on them it can be said that a fully loaded car, complete with luggage, would have to meet a pretty stiff gradient in order to get up them. From Edge Hill and Sandring Hill the 1 in 10 on second gear at 16 to 20 m.p.h., and on third gear at 20 to 30 m.p.h., half-way in both cases, the car will climb up which some cars will usually struggle to get up. Also, a 100 ft. long hill will accommodate a car with 20 m.p.h. down to third gear at 10 m.p.h.

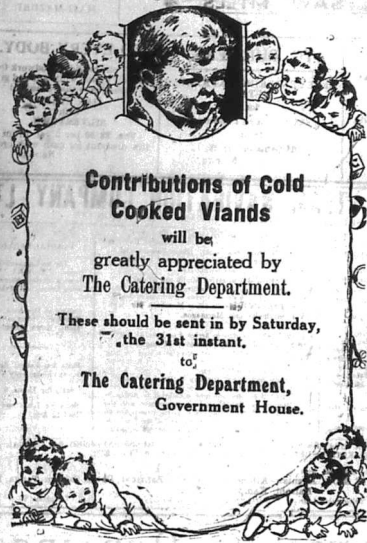

INCREASING PREVALENCE OF TUBERCULOSIS.

Conditions Which Aid Disease.

MALARIA IN NAIROBI.

M.O.N. and Preventive Measures.

On the occurrence of each outbreak of Plague in the various districts isolation of the population resulting in the area with anti-plague vaccine was immediately undertaken, says the Medical Officer of Health for Nairobi in the course of his annual report. Although it has been impossible to collect any reliable evidence as to the protective powers of the vaccine experience in other parts of the world suggests that isolation as a prophylactic measure is probably of some value.

PURBURNAL SEPTICEMIA.

During the year 5 cases were reported, 3 of which occurred in Nairobi and 2 in the Kiambu district.

RELAPSING FEVER.

24 cases were notified during the year, of which 40 occurred in Nairobi and in the adjoining districts. Owing to the fact that many of the cases were not notified until a considerable period of time had elapsed, investigations in regard to the source of infection in these cases could not be made. The great majority of cases occurred amongst African labourers and from the evidence obtained when circumstances permitted it was found

in almost every instance that they had developed the disease of some other arrival in Nairobi. The majority of the case gave a history of having resided in an infected area a short time previously, namely in the County of Nyasa Province where the disease is known to be prevalent. Although several houses where cases had occurred were carefully examined for the presence of the tick (orthodromus moubata) which carries the disease, it was not discovered. From the information received it may be stated that the cases investigated acquired the infection in the Nyasa Province on their journey to Nairobi. While there is no evidence to show that the disease, as yet, has been spread locally, should the tick be or become prevalent in the district a serious menace to the community would particularly when considered in relation to the African labour supply.

The disease, amongst others, emphasizes the importance of the provision of modern sanitary housing for African labour, an existing housing in most instances provides ideal harborage for the relapsing fever tick.

Each batch of lymph was carefully tested in Nairobi before being issued to the health officers. Owing to the large numbers of vaccinations performed it was quite impossible to check the results in most instances, but wherever circumstances permitted results were recorded both in Nairobi and the districts and in every case a high success rate was obtained.

Although a large amount of the time of the Health Officer staff has been devoted to vaccination work during the year, the results have been annually successful and the population of the town and district may now be stated to be fairly well protected against the disease of TUBERCULOSIS.

Ninety-nine cases of Tuberculosis were notified, of which 44 occurred in Nairobi and 55 in the Kiambu and Nairobi districts. As compared with 54 cases from both areas in 1919 and 23 cases in 1918. During the year there has been considerable increase in the incidence of the disease.

VECCINATION.

The prevalence of Smallpox in the Colony in general, more particularly in Mombasa in the early part of the year and later on in the Port Har district, gave rise to considerable apprehensions. Owing to the long incubation period of the disease, the possibility of a serious outbreak occurring in Nairobi or the adjoining districts where the population was known to

be largely unopposed against the disease had to be seriously considered. The possibility being as stated, it was recommended that an attempt should be made to vaccinate every individual who was residing in the area. A European health officer and twenty natives were engaged for the purpose of giving an intensive vaccination campaign. The vaccination unit, complete with transport and equipment, which could be moved to any part of the district, was immediately despatched to small

by notices in the Press and other means that the public were warned of the purpose of the campaign and advised to avail themselves of the facilities for vaccination provided. The systematic vaccination of the population given an intensive vaccination campaign. Large numbers of persons being vaccinated at their health officer's daily, and in addition houses to house visits were made in all parts of the town and suburbs. On the completion of this work the mobile unit was sent north to the Kiambu and Nairobi districts, vaccination staff being carried out on all European farms and estates, and after that in the Native reserves. By the end of the year the work was completed, 150,000 persons having been vaccinated.

No serious difficulties were experienced in carrying out this work. Little opposition was rendered or other activities occurred and the opposition and assistance trade by all sections of the population was much appreciated by the Health Officer staff.

Each batch of lymph was carefully tested in Nairobi before being issued to the health officers. Owing to the large numbers of vaccinations performed it was quite impossible to check the results in most instances, but wherever circumstances permitted results were recorded both in Nairobi and the districts and in every case a high success rate was obtained.

MOTURING TOPICS

WHEEL WOBBLING

Notes on an Intriguing Problem.

NO SOLUTIONS YET

Why does a wheel wobble?

Of late years this has become a very important problem, not only as a matter of car comfort, but because of the serious phenomenon that occurs, sometimes, in the front wheels and is unshared, it is really only in Great Britain, but in that the trouble is prevalent; it is not only with few makes of cars, but with many, and it is even a question of every car of a given make exhibiting this tendency.

What happens? The front wheels set up a violent vibration which at a certain speed, and the car becomes very uncomfortable to drive. Moreover, when wobble sets in at times is dangerous, and is quite likely to overcome one or other of the main parts of the steering gear.

In the early days wheel flap was appreciated, though not to the extent that it is now, and the problem may possibly be aggravated by very big soft tyres. With the motor type of hard tyres which flap could be caused by increasing the slope of the steering pivot to make the car steadier at high speeds.

In fact, some cars which do not wobble steadily at very high speeds but wobble when the car is slow, are pronounced wheel flap when travelling slowly. Generally speaking, wheel flap at low speeds occurs at a lower rate of turn than at high speeds.

TWO DISTINCT TYPES

Another form of wheel flap took place when the car was old, and there was much play in the steering joints, but this could be cured of course by adjusting all the joints steering gear itself. Further, one which had what is known as castor, which gives steering neutral to absorb a greater tendency to wheel flap than those where the inclination centre line of the steering pivot produced touched the road at the centre of the contact of the tyre with the road.

At times the fact that the front wheels were out of parallel would cause wheel flap, but in all these cases there was a definite cause and a definite remedy. That is not the case now and why wheel flap used to take place.

Wheel flap does occur usually at about 40 m.p.h. and very commonly at about 50 m.p.h. It occurs in two different types and is not the same. The American Automobile Association, and Mr. H. Healey, pointed out in their paper, entitled "Front Wheel Wobble," published by the Institution of Automobile Engineers, Watlington House, Adolph, W.C.2.

One type is caused by the wheels pivoting rapidly first in one direction, then in another, and the second jump from the ground in the other being on the ground in the other being on the ground in the first state of things which sets up a sideways sway, owing to gyroscopic action.

Many efforts have been made to overcome wheel flap, but the fact that the apparent cause is entirely different from that in itself different demonstrates either that the real reason has not been discovered or that wheel flap can be caused by a number of things acting in conjunction, as separately.

MERITS OF EACH CASE

For example one manufacturer who was building a large car, either car or truck, found it difficult by lowering the steering gear ratio, recommended over the front wheel, and so giving the driver a greater flap was not very severe. In the other case obviously the wheel flap was caused by the steering gear ratio, the angle of the front axle pivots, or the trouble of all sorts, because it is as far as the range of speed of the car would, however at higher speed all the wheel flap might have occurred.

In yet another case, again with a 1,200 c.c. car, the wheel flap was greatly reduced by decreasing the angle of the pivot. Shock absorber adjustment affected the shows that the stiffness, which gives rise to a bearing on the question, while in another the question is the type of the suspension.

The phenomenon is the more curious because one firm had the alternating experience of discovering

that the remedy varied with the individual car. That is to say, if it had wheel flap, the wheel flap was increased the counter angle, in the other, in a third by decreasing the counter angle and in a fourth by increasing the counter angle, but the remedy for one car did not apply to the other.

So complicated has the question become that at least one authority has stated that he is able, temporarily, to cure wheel flap by shaking the steering wheel vigorously whenever the flap occurs.

Mr. Healey's paper is extremely interesting, not so much because it suggests a remedy, but because it tends to confirm that there is a remedy, namely in view of many cases, and not the least an interesting thing to suggest is that the car depression of weight on the front axle has a great deal to do with the trouble. Certainly, the position of the axle side pivot relative to the wheel has something to do with it, and one is inclined to think that the weight also is a factor.

There is another curious point to be noted. Cars with vertical spines appear to be more troublesome than cars with an inclined spine, despite the fact that wheel flap is not so bad on cars with wheel flap very badly indeed.

Another interesting point is that the tyre pressure has a considerable effect, at all events, in determining the amount of wheel flap. For example, in a car which suffered at 20 m.p.h. from wheel flap at 35 m.p.h. with 20 lb. tyre pressure, it drove quite comfortably up to 48 m.p.h. with 20 lb. pressure in the tyre, but the wheel flap recommenced between 48 and 50 m.p.h. Tyre pressure tyre pressure is a factor.

It does not seem as though inclined tyre had much effect on that type of flap, which occurs when both wheels are on the ground, but it certainly seems as though it should have an effect on the other type of wheel flap wherein the wheels leave the road alternately. This at all events, has been noted in racing where a car with substantial wheel flap is made to race, it holds it off quite well when the wheels are balanced. The effect, however, is not quite that of wheel flap, but of late years much machinery

has been added to the front wheels. This is a point also dealt with by Mr. Healey. Not only are the tyres now made with a tread which has been added, and that has increased when the wheel flap has been added at the same time, but the increase and almost simultaneously with low pressure tyres, which admittedly tend to wobble when the flap is complained the trouble.

On the face of it a brake drum should be an easy thing to balance. Its material should be sufficiently homogeneous and it should be sufficiently even to make the drum itself practically a balance. But it is not always certain that the drum on account of its material, which the most wheel revolves, and it is unbalanced from one side, the wheels were set up, due to this cause, the wheels might have the road alternately and could produce the second form of wheel flap. 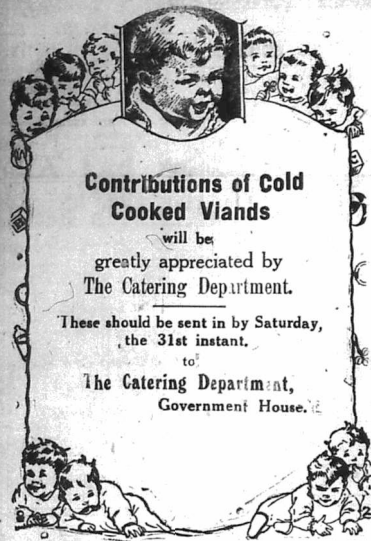

REVIEW OF MAIZE INDUSTRY IN KENYA.

Encouraging Report by the Director of Agriculture.

THE GRADING SYSTEM.

Its Value Reflected in Year's Returns.

Following His Excellency's special speech at the Fourth Maize Conference on Wednesday, the Director of Agriculture (Mr. Hon. Alex. Holm, C.B.E.) presented his annual report as follows:—

Effort has been given to all the recommendations of the last Conference in regard to alterations to Grading Rules, and the various Grades. The Revised Rules were printed and published in booklet form.

The proposals then made were accepted by Corn Trade Associations overseas. Fifty sets of Standard Samples were made up and distributed to the Kenya Farmers Association, Native Farmers Maize Growers Ltd., E. M. Trade Commissioner, Trade Commission for South Africa, East African Trade and Information Bureau, London, and Local Shipping Agents; also to Corn Trade Associations in Great Britain and to various firms engaged in the Maize trade in England and in Kenya. Sets were also issued for display at Railway Stations and Administrative Offices in the more important Maize producing centres.

The preparation of these Standard Samples demands care and judgment, and it is satisfactory to note that they have proved acceptable both to Shippers and to Trade.

Two well attended Meetings of the Maize Grading Committee have been held, when the following subjects were dealt with:—

- (1) Report of Maize in Bulk with bags returnable to the Port.
- (2) Report of Maize Metal-removalists from the Liverpool Corn Trade Association.
- (3) Report of Maize in Port on the Home's Coast.
- (4) Maize Conditioning Plant—Change.
- (5) Bookbinding.
- (6) Island weighing.
- (7) Railway freight rates on—

- (8) Maize and Maize Meal for local consumption.
 - (9) Breakish lines.
 - (10) Arrangements for Fourth Maize Conference.
- Reference will be made to the recommendations of the Committee when these subjects come up for discussion at the Conference, also under appropriate heads in this report.

In Appendix A to this report for the year are given the quantities of Maize, inspected and graded each month, from July 1923 to June 1924 inclusive. Summarized it indicates that out of a total of 22,110 bags offered for grading 9,345 or 42 per cent. were rejected for grade, as compared with 54 per cent. during the previous year. Of that figure, 22,500 bags or 55 per cent. were "wet"; 7,154 or 158 per cent. were "Mist"; 14,507 or 839 per cent. were "weedy"; and 5,791 or 133 per cent. were rejected for other reasons. 375,744 bags were accepted for grade and shelled into the following grades:

It will be noted that the quantity of maize offered for grading has fallen considerably as compared with the previous year, the figure being 713,479 bags for 1923-24 and 221,110 for 1924-25. But a larger quantity of ungraded maize was shelled to the Indian Coast in 1923-24 than in the previous year. Figures for 1923-24 were:—

REBAGGING AND REWEAVING.

8,617 bags were re-bagged, and 3,667 bags were re-woven by the Uganda Railway. In addition to this, following rejection by the Grading, 270 bags were re-bagged and 1,500 re-woven, 1,491 re-bagged and 1,528 re-woven in part by the owner.

SHORTAGE OF WHEAT.

Since the operation of the new rule dealing with the weighing of ten per cent. of consignments, 121 truck loads containing 22,560 bags were rejected as under weight.

REGRADING.

2,943 bags were re-graded, of which it was necessary to alter the grade of 352.

GRAINERS' ACCOUNT.

Appendix II furnishes a statement of the Grading Account for the period under review. It will be recalled that in previous years the results could only be effected after subtraction.

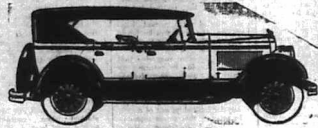

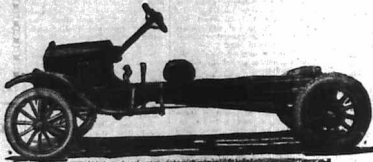

**MUTUAL RELATION OF WHITE
AND BLACK RACES.**

**Striking Sermon by a Tanganyika
Chaplain.**

NEW TESTAMENT TEACHING.

Its Application to Modern African Conditions.

The Epistle extracts called forth by the Rev. D. H. Reynolds M.A., the Chaplain of Dar-es-Salaam and Mwanza, Mr. Reynolds has had a long experience of coloured races in China, India, and Africa and his subject was "The mutual relation of the white and black races." He mentioned four general principles in support of his subject, the first being that the New Testament never asserted the equality of mankind. Mankind is common destiny, but whether the future might hold it otherwise the white race is at present race, and its general relation to other races was that of a father and not that of a peer. The New Testament asserted nothing more than the brotherhood of mankind.

EQUALITY AMONGST RACES.

Methodism did not imply equality in all the varied relationships of life. An older brother might be and sometimes was a father of a younger brother. St. Paul in 1 Timothy 6:2 says: "If thou have Christian believers in thy master, must not take them with them because they are brethren. They must be all the better servants because thou who art their lord." The second principle is that race should be punished, but that such punishment should be in a de-

GRADIENT TO AUTHORITY.

In Dr. Moffatt's translation of the New Testament, it is written in the first four verses of Romans 13:

"Every subject must obey the Government's authority, for the authority exists apart from God; the existing authorities have been constituted by God."

"Whosoever therefore who resist authority is opposing the Divine order, and the opposition will

bring judgment on themselves. I am not saying that you are to obey the Government, though they are to be obeyed. If you wish to avoid punishment, do not resist the Government. If you do resist, you will be punished for it." Magistrate is God's servant for your benefit. But if you do wrong, you may well be alarmed, a magistrate does not wield the power of the sword for nothing. He is God's servant for the infliction of Divine vengeance upon evil doers."

DISTINCTION IN CLASSES.

Dating with the punishment of black and white men, Mr. Reynolds said that St. Paul clearly approved of the general principle of making a distinction in the punishment given to different classes of men when he himself was arrested at Jerusalem.

The Roman authorities were pleased to stop him being ignorant of the fact that he was a Roman citizen and he turned to the Centurion and said: "I am a Roman citizen." He said that to escape a Roman citizen? He did not say that it was a thing to be ashamed of, but he was making a distinction in the kind of punishment to be given to different classes of men. He said that what might be a very severe punishment for a white man might be quite trifling for a black man, but the distinction was in the knowledge of the conditions in England, the terrible thing was that a white man was a Roman citizen while a black man was a native of an inferior race.

A TERROR TO WHOSO POWER.

Contrary to the teaching of St. Paul, Magistrate in this part of the world was very often not a "terror" to the native wrong-doer because the punishment which the magistrate was quite inadequate. There was only one punishment for the black man (apart from execution) and

that was Corporal punishment. Such punishment was administered to British boys and public schools, and criminals and convicts were allowed to see younger boys. Surely then, since everyone knew that the natives had the knowledge of a child, it could not be wrong to give the black man the same punishment as the white man.

THE DEATH PENALTY.

The Rev. Mr. Reynolds declared that the New Testament nowhere declared that the death penalty should be inflicted in cases of murder. The only cases of capital punishment were punishable with death. In praising the forgiveness of wrongs done to oneself, there was no reference to public punishment, and in the famous words "Render to Caesar also things that are Caesar's," he set the stern system of Government which existed under the Roman Empire.

PUNISHMENT AS A DETERRENT.

In dealing with punishment as a deterrent, Mr. Reynolds said that St. Paul clearly laid it down that the punishment should be of such a nature as to deter men from committing similar offences. Magistrate was a force to be feared, and a terror to the wrong-doer. When people were hanged in England for robbery, it was found that it did not deter others from committing similar offences. Capital punishment for such offences was quite rightly abolished. But with preventive justice it has been proved in Rhodesia and elsewhere, that capital punishment for certain cases of brutal assault has a deterrent nature, and has been effective in stamping out such crimes. It is said therefore that according to St. Paul's teaching, it is a deterrent.

COMPULSORY LABOUR.

The fourth principle mentioned by the Rev. Mr. Reynolds is that the New Testament nowhere teaches that compulsory labour is necessarily wrong.

In point of fact it does not even specifically condemn the slavery which existed throughout the Roman Empire, though it appears to condemn it. It is said that the Apostle Paul was a slave himself, and he said that the institution of slavery was not a public offence. The slavery in one thing and compulsory labour is another. BRITISH IMPERIALISM.

"I feel that as a nation we cannot escape the charge of hypocrisy. We have that as a motto in living under the British flag, but it is going on all the time. I mean the slavery of native, Indian, and Chinese." "You have it here in Africa, and you have it in India, and you have it in Hongkong. And yet the people of all homes who make such a feast show a higher native being tempted to do a moderate amount of work, more often a word about the slaves of the native women and children which goes on under the British flag."
