The memorable date of May 23, 1911, saw the inception of the Landholders' Association in British East Africa. 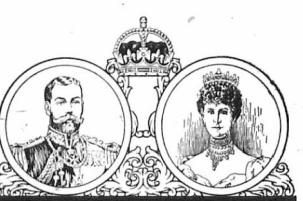

ISSUE REPORT.

(Hester's Special to "E. A. Standard.") London, Oct. 21.

The report of the Railway Commission, which was formed on August 22, for 12 months, with a view to their present, unanimously proposed the retention of the Consolidation Scheme of 1907, with alterations and extensions. It says it is most important to facilitate discussion by the companies and prior to a report to the sectional Consultation Boards. The Central Board are abolished. If the men's and employers' sides of the Boards are unable to agree, they can call in a chairman whom to appoint, they can call in a chairman whom to appoint, if they are unable to agree on a selection by the Board of Trade, they can appoint a chairman whose duties shall be final and will operate immediately.

The powers of the Boards, which hitherto were confined to wages and hours, are extended to take in conditions of service, but not to discipline and management as they are excluded. No provision is made for the protection of the Union, but a step in this direction is contained in a provision that the secretary of the men's side of the Boards may be a non-employee of the company and empowered to act as the men's advocate.

(To the Editor of the "E. A. Standard.") Sir—Whilst glancing yesterday I observed a phenomenon, part of which, at least, can be explained. I am not sure I intended if any of your readers could suggest an explanation. As I have another announcement next week the following observations are of the very recent. About 10.30 a.m. I noticed two extremely bright suns in a clear sky, which gradually faded to correspond to the suns familiar with which some, who might prefer to see the appearance about 10.30 respectively.
