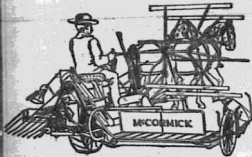

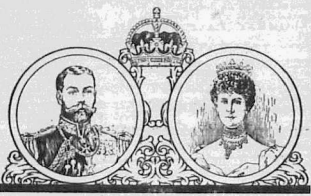

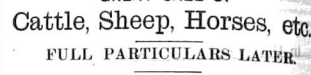

## Home Rule.

Redmond's Reception.

(Best's Special to "E. A. Standard.") Mr. Redmond addressed an important meeting in the City of London Club under the auspices of the Government. His speech was greeted with the Master of the House, Mr. Parnell, Sir John Lubbock and other prominent Liberals were on the platform. Mr. Redmond had a cordial reception. He dealt with economical and financial aspects of Home Rule but emphasized the capacity of the Irish for industrial pursuits and the fact that if Government would aid the revival of industries, Great Britain had a native Government composed of men understanding the country's great questions and that of treating them never so well settled. It had been said that Ireland was a beggar accepting county job her country into a Imperial expense for the upkeep of the army and navy and Empire had been 225 millions for the past century, which was a pretty good contribution for a people.

He admitted Ireland's contribution had fallen enormously owing to increased cost of the Irish administration which as present was the most costly in the world largely because it was a poor country led to a rich partner who Ireland had to support in its luxuries. Ireland had no interest in economic but under self-Government it would waste money on ceremonial decorations, highly paid officers, extravagant legislative salaries as at present. He concluded that the only safety for the British Treasury by making a bargain with Ireland, making her responsible for her own Government which would be along and self-sustained and would be an more a drain on the British Treasury. Parliamentary conquests necessitated Home Rule all round. Home Rule was also necessary to give the best of the people and loyalty of the Irish and their cooperation in upholding the Empire (some chafers) a vote of thanks to Mr. Redmond was moved by the Master of the House.

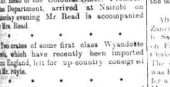
