AREA AND RATING

The Local Government Commission completed its hearing of evidence yesterday and its坐席 on October 28 before Dr. R. Hunter, First Medical Officer of Health, and Mr. W. O. Mitchell were heard.

Dr. Hunter advocated a return to the present relations between the Municipal Officer of Health and the Municipality to the normal system elsewhere of the British Empire where the Medical Officer of Health is subject to the same conditions as to responsibility and independence by the Central Health Department of Government. His

Dr. Hunter also dealt with the need for drastic measures to combat the spread of malaria and submitted to the Commission copies of his memorandum to the Municipality which have already appeared in the "Standard".

He also gave an estimate of the extent of the work the Municipality can include all the services of the medical officer of health, one controlling authority for the whole area.

He also submitted his memorandum on the lines of the memorandum which is published below.

Dr. Hunter's memorandum is as follows:

The position of the relation of the Medical Officer of Health to the Local Authority arises only in so far as the Local Authority has the power to appoint him. This local government is in the hands of the inhabitants through their representatives elected by them.



I would reply to questions 1 and 2 together.

In my opinion, Nairobi and its environs should be constituted as a county and governed by one local authority. This would be the most suitable form of administration. There should be no suburban areas or towns which are not included in the County Council or Corporation.

Areas such as Kilimani, and Mombasa should be included in the County Council. It would be better to suggest exactly where the boundaries should be drawn, than to copy the principle that "wherever convenient".

The question has in mind a situation in which there is a

present need to increase the number of county commissioners.

United as governments of different countries they often have nothing in common.

LABOUR DIFFICULTIES

Lugard: I hold the view that the best way to meet the labour problem is to continue to use the raw materials and foodstuffs to keep the population down to the number required by the available work which is a reciprocal benefit to the African and the European. The former, these problems were not so acute as to necessitate the regulation of their numbers, but the latter with the webbing of the economy and the increasing pressure of immigration - compelled by price, taxation, and other factors - to migrate to the cities, and resulted in a mass emigration of the European population leaving others to care for the welfare of the country.

The bulk of the European population previously had no handbook, principally because of the lack of any definite basis upon which to regulate their status or conditions of employment. Many do not return, and a claim of "undesirable" can easily grow up from this circumstance, particularly if the European does not understand the local conditions and the proportionate demands. I have no objection to the European in fact, but it is a long step forward to regulate him in Britain and India. In the Colonies, in addition may probably be in the country of the European, there is a similar problem. I do not believe that the racial question may arise, but each village should consist of no heterogeneous group, and the European should be a settled, quiet, industrious, and peaceful member of the community, sharing freedom, opportunity, and observing their additional conditions.

NEGLECT OF THE CAR

Protecting It from Its Driver.

EFFECT OF MISUSE

New and again we have the same old story of drivers who give a free hand to their mechanics. Most of them are not even drivers themselves. Very often they are people who have never had a car or who have little knowledge of how to drive it. They are drivers who have on little feeling for the care of their cars.
