## THE MEN OF THE CARRIER CORPS

The following notes are from the men themselves:

"For the first time I have had a chance to appear in public. In addition to the usual duties of a carrier, I have been given the task of being a spokesman for our Corps. This has been most difficult, as it is not always easy to express what we carried out to our men. The men of the Carrier Corps have been most helpful and have always been ready to help us in our work."

"The note of 1,162-11-9 which still exists in the files of our Corps, was written by the Carrier Corps on the 11th November 1918, to the War Office, asking that we be granted a day off not only in recognition of the Armistice, but also to allow those who had fought so bravely to go home and rest. This was granted and we were allowed to go home."

"The two tablets to the memory of those heroes of Zimmo who laid down their lives for their country will be a lasting reminder of the sacrifice made in the porch of the Faso Memorial Hall."

"They read—  
'Those who fall in this place, let this of you be said, their names are worthy of your death.'

"This gave our men the will to do their best."

"A richer Harvest are you all than we can ever hope to reap."

And a final note:

"Those we make happy, be no less with us now.  
Those we make unhappy, say no longer come."

"Many valiant, early makeshift  
Monsters had to shun us all."


