

Inquiry Leads to Further Arrests

Cairo, January 8.—The protruding eyebrows of the series of political crimes committed in Cairo recently culminating in the killing of the English Consul, Sir Philip Stirling, are nearly completed, and the British Foreign Minister, Sir Arthur Henderson, has issued a circular to the Egyptian Government requesting the services of his Excellency Mr. J. M. Thompson, Commissioner of Police, London, and Sir Edward Williams, Commissioner of the Royal Mint, to assist him in the inquiry.

There is a danger that the inquiry will prove difficult, since the criminal who committed the murder was an Englishman, and there is a likelihood that he has been aided and abetted by persons who have no connection with one of the other countries mentioned above. The British Consul, Sir Philip Stirling, was a man of considerable experience and his death has come in the middle of a period in which the relations between Britain and Egypt have been strained to the limit.

There is a danger that the criminal who committed the murder was an Englishman, and there is a likelihood that he has been aided and abetted by persons who have no connection with one of the other countries mentioned above. 
