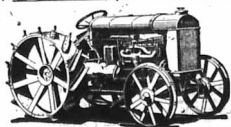

London, Feb. 26.  
After prolonged debate, which was closed at 10.15 o'clock in the morning, the House of Commons adopted, by 137 votes to 96 a motion resolution authorizing the introduction of a Bill extending the duration of trade facilities and the Overseas Trade Act.

SETTLER REPRESENTS

His Excellency the Governor made a trench announcement on the subject of the appointment of selected settlers as Magistrates in country districts during his comprehensive speech at the opening of the Convention of Associations this week. In expressing his views he has expressed the proposal a step further than it has advanced previously and in giving his personal support and encouragement he has made a long speech from his belief in white settlement and the relationship between European and African in the Colony. He has no doubt that suitable men are available and, as he has indicated, is perfectly assured to extend, as the critics of the community suggest, that men who are morally upright and sound in opinion, possessing a firm sense of justice and imbued with traditions of Church and College and Home-normal hard-working clean living, British—should evidently become degraded and perverted, unable to acknowledge justice and incapable of exercising common sense. He selected settlers are given the responsibility of administering justice in areas in which they are recognized by African and European alike as upright, self-respecting, tolerant, just men, they will perform their work not only with a full sense of their great responsibility, but also acutely conscious of the fact that upon their administration depends indirectly the reputation of the British in Native Africa, liable to be, if served it is, rather on the side of leniency towards the native than otherwise and conscious—more so than their critics at Home—that behind them stand the higher Courts of East Africa with the final power of remission and execution. The appointment of settlers as Magistrates does not amount, as some individuals imagine, to the placing of any measure of power in the hands of unauthorized persons; any action is checked and liable to amendment and the subject against injustice will be increased rather than decreased by the appointment of non-official magistrates. His Excellency has pointed out some of the difficulties. You must, he said, have simplified legislation, simplified procedure and the satisfaction of trained court clerks. Having identified those difficulties and recognized that he has proposed to give the problem, he has proceeded to study with the assistance of legal experts. We find, he said, that, as soon as we arrived at a decision he will communicate it to the country with his suggested that action will be placed in responsible positions at once, the development of a system must be one of very gradual and careful growth spread over many years. 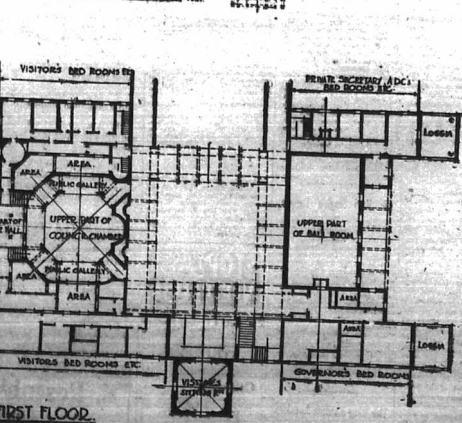
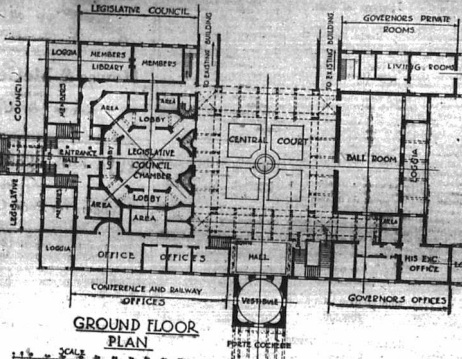

THE WHITE SHIRT.

It was inevitable that the subject of the political future of the Highlands area of this country as affected by the White Paper of 1925, would be raised in an earnest way by the community in Kenya, and we commended to the Government for careful study the report of the Convention of Associations lately published this morning. There is, no necessity, now or in the future, for the use of extreme language for acute realisation of the hazards of any kind. The White Paper has been in operation for two and a half years, and it is within the rights of the people of the country to gauge and take stock of the position. Some of the results, as a consequence of the operation of the White Paper policy are, beyond the difficulties and complications of the situation, we have no doubt that if the Indian community gave attention to looking taking in the same form on their behalf they would be able to provide an equitably formidable list of problems and queries. The White Paper policy as we understand it at this time, was one for judicious application; indicative principles capable of being stated and partially applied and revised. Here if those principles have been applied or the possible consequences of their application studied and known, it is quite reasonable to say that the people of the Highlands and the Lowlands of Kenya still remain unaffected and unaffected effect is made to be applied to place a geographical limit to the area, the element of danger from dispute and discussion will always remain present. We cannot believe that the method adopted by the Land Officer of delineating a non-existing boundary by soundings the system of settlers' own fences, through or against the system of purchase titles and transfers will be of any satisfactory or conclusive, and if the Commissioner's definition of Highlands as any area generally suitable for the white settlement is correct, it must surely be appropriate by geographical and climatic conditions and considerations contained in the history of settlement during the past twenty years and ascertainable with some accuracy. In any event, other and restricted discussion and considerations may address the whole subject on the present Indian title and quite satisfactory steps can be fully fair and just to Indians and Europeans, that some finality should be reached if the White Paper principles are to be incorporated, even approximately, in the general fabric of the country.
