




MURDER PLAN TO
DISCHARGE.Echo of the Northern
Frontier Tragedy.

The Tanga plan to discharge natives contains the text of a Bill entitled "An Act to regulate contracts between the Government and natives." The Bill is now before the Legislative Council.

The principal object of the Bill is to regulate contracts between the Government and natives by giving the Minister power to make regulations for the award of contracts, both by the Government or by any other authority or body of persons, for the performance of any work or service, or for the supply of any material or article, to any native.

Under the Bill, no native shall be compelled to enter into a contract with the Government or any other authority or body of persons, if he so far as possible would not do so.

The chief object of the scheme is to give the natives a better position in practice than they have hitherto enjoyed. They are to be allowed to withdraw from a contract if it is to their interest to do so, and to enter into another if they prefer.







The lorry had been driven down the road by a driver of the company's drivers, and it had run into the rear of another vehicle, which had been driven by one of the company's drivers. The lorry was completely destroyed, and the driver was taken to hospital. Within 40 hours of the heavy loss the company came through with heavy losses, but managed to make a profit of £100.

It is understood that the truck had been driving along the road from Nairobi and passed the heavy load. It had turned sharply to the right when it fell down an embankment 30 feet high.

The extraordinary part of the accident was that the lorry was completely destroyed out of all proportion to the size of the truck, which had only suffered a slight dent.

The lorry and trailer, which can be seen in the illustration, were owned by the Ocean Co. through Messrs. E. J. & Sons, Ltd., of the British Transport Commission. They are still looking for the truck, and have sent a telegram to the police asking for assistance in the search for the damaged truck.
