





CRIMES OF VIOLENCE.

His Excellency Issues a Manifesto

to the Natives.

His Excellency the Governor is causing to be communicated to all sections of the native peoples, through the most suitable channels, the following manifesto. The Message will be broadcast through the Press, administrative officers, chiefs and headmen in all areas and it be brought before the notice of every African.

In native schools opportunity will be sought to imess upon the pupils the meaning of the manifesto.

His Excellency's message reads:

His Excellency the Governor has ordered all leaders of native tribes to be informed of the deep indignation and anxiety with which he has learnt of recent crimes against European women by African men. Orimes of this nature cause horror among all civilized peoples throughout the world. It is essential to African welfare that they should be stopped.

All young African men must be made to realise what shame and reprobation are brought upon their people by the authors of Wil. these crimes. The disgrace spreads from the guilty to all their kith and kin, and must gravely prejudice that progress of the African peoples which Government has at heart. disease which enters one or two plants and injures the whole crop.

The Governor therefore calls upon all official headmen, elders and native councillors publicly to condemn these crimes and to exert to the utmost their influence among their own people to prevent any recurrence of them in Kenya Colony. The leaders of the young men also must speak with all young men in order that none may be ignerant how detestable are these crimes and how grave the punishment

GOVERNMENT FOR ITS PART WILL LEAVE NO STONE UNTURNED TO BRING ALL OFFENDERS TO JUSTICE. IF THE LAW AS IT STANDS IS NOT A SUFFICIENT DETER-RENT, ITS SEVERITY WILL BE INCREASED. THE INTEREST OF THE WHOLE COLONY DEMANDS THAT CRIME OF THE CHARACTER BE RIGOROUSLY STAMPED OUT.


