HIS EXCELLENCY'S OPENING ADDRESS.

New Transport Proposals.

SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES AND FURTHER LEGISLATION.

The session of the Legislative Council was resumed in the Municipal Hall, Nairobi, on Wednesday at 10 a.m.

The Oath was administered to the following—Evan Ebenezer Biss, Acting Director of Education, Walter Mitchell, Acting Director of Public Works, Joseph H. B. Egan, O.B.E., Acting Sub-director of the Police, Alfred W. C. M.B.E., Provisional Member for Nairobi North, William James, Provisional Member for Nairobi East, Major Edward P. H. O'Connell, Provisional Member for Nairobi South.

In his opening speech, His Excellency the Governor said:

Honourable Members of Council—

It is a pleasure to me to be on the business on which Council has been called together this week. I am sure you would be ready to express the pleasure of the Colony at the presence in the midst of His Excellency the Governor, the Hon. the Member for the East Indies Square, and of the presence with which we have welcomed the Hon. the Member for Nairobi. The Hon. the Member for the East Indies Square is one of the mainstays of the British Empire and there would be no Colony if there had been no Navy. We therefore in the Colony—and I am sure I speak for everyone in the Colony—particular pleasure all visits which can be paid to us by the East Indies Squadron. We are glad to have this with us this year and we look forward to a more extended visit next year.

The business before Council this week is practical but unimportant. I have called Council together not because there was any special urgency in the matters you will have to discuss, but because it is almost throughout the year should keep well ahead of its business, so as to avoid meetings on the occasion of important questions, and so as to avoid in particular the accumulation of arrears.

The first purpose is an increase in the salaries and staff of the Police in different parts of the Colony and in particular in the Northern Frontier District. The Government of Police has been encountering many difficulties, particu-

At present these laws are very antiquated and they would have to be amended if we were to introduce a new Town Planning Bill. 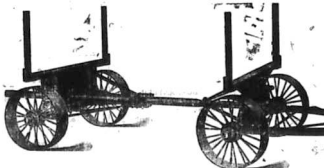
