Railway Development and Rates.

"There seems to be a certain opinion abroad," said the Acting General Manager of Railways in his recent report, "that the Railway should undertake at once a thorough revision of rates and standards of all-round conditions. I agree, he continued, "that some of our rates are high, perhaps in certain commodities especially high, but I would like to point out that in numerous instances our rates are undoubtedly low. I am no means aware to a revision of rates—but only when the time opportunes." In a further section of the same document, dealing with what he termed "the long" called "policy" of the Department, the Acting General Manager pointed out that every penny that could be secured out of revenue has had to go back into the betterment of the line and until the large arrears have been overthrown "it would be imprudent policy to embark upon any reductions in rates. He added that General charges were increasing (they will be almost 500,000,000 in 1922 on the present lines) and the budget will continue to increase as new lines are opened for traffic although the new lines would be roughly being covered revenue, he contended it is very doubtful whether extra earnings will be sufficient to cover working and interest charges. In the case of the main Kinshasa Railway, the interest charges will exceed 3,000,000 per annum and that of other branches, and therefore the annual interest charges, will unfortunately be increased to an even heavier volume of labour and the industry in completion caused by the liability of the Railway to transport the construction materials with their facilities, and the result to which the General Manager, in connection with rate reduction is very widespread. The general view of the commercial classes in this country is that the present rates upon the various imported articles constitute a serious barrier on the commodity which contribute in an considerable manner to the growing cost of living which is such a bad advertisement for this country as well as a definite impeding upon expansion of trade and development. The rates are, to some extent, increased by the low charges which are made for exported produce and the fact will eventually arrive when the whole rate policy of the Railway must receive close investigation. At the present time the Government, without consulting public opinion in any way, has put forward proposals for considerable extension of main railway routes to wards the Congo and Indian to be financed from the ten million loan and, at the same time, the General Manager has referring to the increased rates in London that a further loan will probably be necessary to build the large trunk railway programme for which provision has been made for any year. In connection with the whole question of the introduction of railway programmes we recommend careful study of the analyses provided by the Acting General Manager in a lengthy document which has been made to our columns. 


