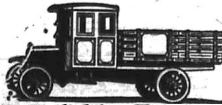

DELEGATES CONFERENCE OF SAFETY MEN.

Resolved to Remain at Work Reaffirmed.

[By WIRELESS.]

The Miners' Council at Johannesburg, where sixty per cent of the men have already returned to work, has decided that it is anxious to continue the coal stoppage and has advised its members to come to terms with the owners. The issue offered in Johannesburg for an eight hours day represents from three pence to five pence per shift advance on pre-war prices.

This is the first attempt to break away from the independence of the Miners' Federation. Just owing to the small number of men employed in Johannesburg the development is in itself insignificant.

It is noteworthy, however, that a similar step is under consideration to-day in the more important District of Johannesburg, where the number of miners is about seven times larger than that of Johannesburg. Eighty per cent of its miners are already at work on the basis of a 7 1/2 hours day, on being supplied with the new rates of Mr. G. A. Hoover M.P., who is consequently now supported by the Federation Council.

The policy of yielding to such a move, to have a strike which would result in a 7 1/2 hour working day, the members of the Federation Council are opposed such a proposal would amount to a complete surrender on the part of the Miners. He said that the only way to get out of the present but he would not compromise by any means.

He would, he added, have to consider his position if decision on this matter were reached with which his fingers lock to work in a situation it was his duty to get out such conditions or get out.

The whole conference was conducted in an atmosphere of trust and goodwill and the feeling of mutual respect was that a real movement had been started and a substantial understanding in trade and industry, between German, Anglo-American and British Official Workers' Services.

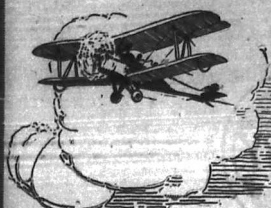

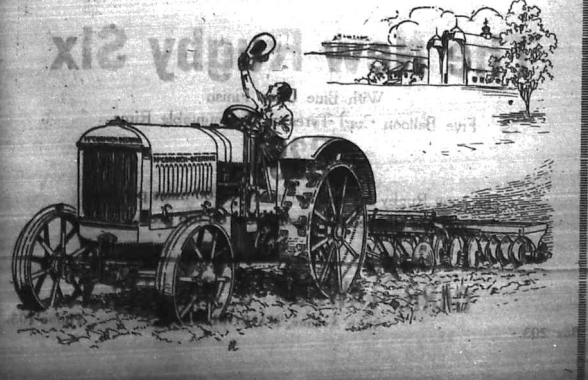

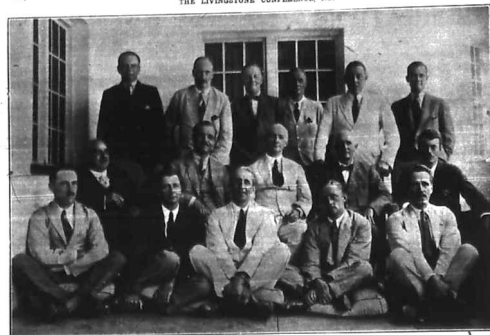

KENYA LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY OPENS BUDGET SESSION

New Principles of Finance Outlined.

NEW FEATURES OF THE DRAFT ESTIMATES, INCREASED EXPENDITURE BUT A SURPLUS OF £46,000.

Address in Present Terms Forwarded.

PORT HEADLOOK BASED BY TEMPORARY INCORPORATION AS A RAILWAY SERVICE: TWO NEW ESTIMES.

The Budget Session of the Kenya Legislative Council was opened on Tuesday in the Memorial Hall, Nairobi, by His Excellency the Governor.

Intervenor in the proceedings was reflected in the attendance of members of the general public who were seated for such a number. The public seats in the Memorial Hall were all occupied long before the arrival of His Excellency and many people had to stand. Lady Grey occupied a chair near the door.

His Excellency who spoke for over half an hour principally with the financial statement of the session. For the first time in the Colony's history, three sets of estimates were presented (1) Colonial (2) Railways, and (3) Port. MUNICIPAL QUARTERS WITHOUT TENANTS.

Fine Houses Built But No Occupants.

Some years back—two at least—the old Town Council in an altruistic spirit, decided to build a quarter for the casual native population of Nairobi. The present Town Council voted the money, and the buildings are nearly completed. There are actually finished out of the twelve being erected. Already £50,000 has been spent. They are nice-looking, one-story houses—made of stone, with red tiled roofs to the four corners. When finished they will be accommodated to the Natives. They have every convenience. There is a kitchen where food can be cooked, and right back leading to a stable door and all the surroundings are in accordance with the accommodations of the M.O.H.

The cost of a lot is not high. Twenty-five cents a night unless the lot is used for a number of months, or Sh. 5/- a month. The Council's property here.

BITT.

But although these built-up flats have been open for two months and a single applicant has asked for a lot!

Fortunately one of the Municipal officers pointed out the fact that there was, and is, a great deal of accommodation for boys employed within the municipal limits. It will mean that 2,000 boys alone in which are over 12 years of age and that provide houses for hundreds of unemployed natives, sleeping in their separate quarters. All this is considered in the M.O.H. as a source to health and to the general welfare.

It may be that the casual population of Nairobi is not known to be provided for there, although the several officials saying that the location Superintendent has indicated that few homes to be located there. There seems to be no information to be had to advertise the fact. Hence the native population is suffering from the Native Affairs Department.

SAVING MONEY.

On the whole, it may be that the casual native laborer has no other means of earning money but prefers to have his home and sleep a few hours on an outside premises, rather than in a Government quarter.

There are these beautiful buildings all ready for occupation but no one to occupy them. The Municipal authorities that have employed of native labor must stand of having their own quarters.

There is another way of forcing the Government to build more quarters and making the Government of a home responsible for the casual native sleeping in their servants' quarters.

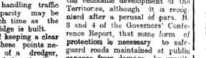
