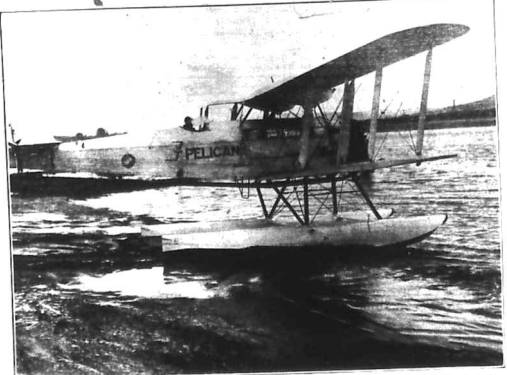

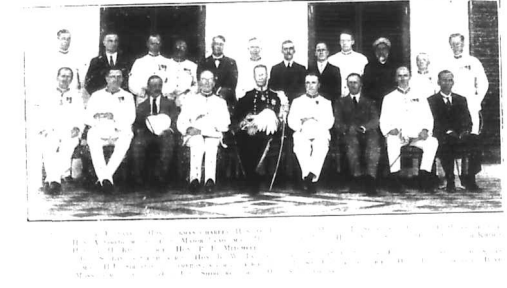


THE KISUMU-KHARTOUM AIR ROUTE.

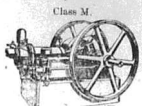

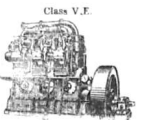

The most successful Show yet organized by the Kenya Horticultural Society was held in the Memorial Hall on Monday last. During the day a large number of persons visited the show, and it was generally agreed that the most credit was reflected on the ability and energy of the committee of the Society for this successful organization.

At 12.30 p.m., Lady Muriel Jeehan, visited by Baroness Buxton, opened the Show in the absence of His Excellency The Governor who was unable to be present on account of urgent business in the Legislative Council.
