The position is still crucial. WORLD'S NEWS. BY CABLE.

Coal Mines Bill.

Balfour Moves Rejection.

SECOND READING PASSED

Exciting Moments.

A HOPE FOR SETTLEMENT.

(Heater's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

London, March 29. Mr. Asquith formally moved the second reading of the Coal Mines Bill.

Mr. Balfour said that on one was satisfied with the proposed solution when the country had been faced with a crisis such as this. He emphasized that an American Trust had ever misused its powers to paralyze trade as the miners' leaders were doing. His condemnation of Mr. Asquith's attitude regarding the agreement between the men and the Welsh and Scottish mineowners. The Government was desirous itself and the House of Commons when it had introduced for the first time this colossal resolution in forty eight hours thus forcing Parliament to abrogate its legitimate functions. Mr. Balfour concluded by assuming that if the Government were defeated there would be no dissolution as they could not add the confusion of a general election to the horrors of the strike. He intimated that the Opposition would have tested the Government's mettle at the second reading. They would do their best to see that the Government's policy had a chance. He moved the rejection of the bill on the ground of national policy.

Mr. Asquith cordially welcomed Mr. Balfour. His speech was worthy of the critical occasion but he had covered the rejection of the bill without any practical suggestion. The Government could not allow the people and industries to be starved, consequently they were bound to obtain a legislative declaration of the reasonableness of the minimum wage, subject to subsequent adjustment. That was the preliminary to any further steps that might be necessary, which God forbid.

The speeches of the miners' members indicated their support of the second reading, but in committee they will insist on 5- and 2- minutes for adult and boy no workers. They would also like to see the miners' schedule included in the bill. It is understood that the Government may pass the second reading but the second will be refused.

The minimum wage Bill passed first reading by 341 votes to 225.

The Laborites and Nationalists voted with the majority which was larger than has been expected. The figures were received with exultant ministerial cheers. Sir E. Grey in winding up the debate intimated that it is impossible for the Government to limit the minimum for boys in the bill. He declared that an early settlement was imperative. Should the bill fail to settle the strike the government would be compelled to protect the nation by every means at its power. The impression is that the lobby is more hopeful for the speedy passage of the bill though it is possible there will be a stiff fight in the committee stage. The coalowners papers say that the Government will accept the 5- and 2- minutes but the "Times" is emphatic in declaring that the Cabinet yesterday decided to remain firm in its refusal to accept these. This is the most interesting factor in the situation which if the strike was not ended by the passage of the bill. The Opposition expects that the government will take other measures. The Government view is that the men will trouble back to work immediately the bill is passed; probably there will be a general resumption by Easter thus justifying their action.

London, March 29.

Mr. King moved an amendment to the Minimum Wage Bill making the minimum 5s. and 2s. for adults and boys respectively. Mr. Asquith refused to accept the amendment as he was not disposed to set a precedent by fixing the rate of wages by act of Parliament. He pointed out that it had dangers in the men as it would tend to treat the 5s. and 2s. as a minimum.

Mr. King's amendment was lost without division but previous to the division the debate took a dramatic turn. The Laborites warned the Government that the rejection of the amendment meant a prolongation of the strike. Then Mr. Ramsey MacDonald interposed by saying that the miners waived the insertion of the district schedules if the 5s. and 2s. minimum were inserted. Mr. King then suggested the withdrawal of Mr. King's amendment in order to discuss Mr. MacDonald's concession. Sir Edward Grey adhered to the inapplicability of any figure in the bill but would inform the House that night.

After this Mr. Asquith rose for Sir Hatfield Williams said it is presumed that negotiations are in progress.

London, March 29. The House of Commons is continuing the consideration of the Coal Mines Bill in the committee stage but discussion is perfunctory as the House is awaiting the result of the negotiations outside. There are included in the conference Mr. Asquith and Mr. Boser Law.

The amendment of Mr. Edwards to incorporate the schedule of the minimum wage was rejected by 367 votes to 55. After further debate Mr. Asquith said he had reason to believe that the day's discussion had so far narrowed the points at issue that a committee stage would contribute to the views of the owners and men on Monday with a view of still further narrowing the differences of the parties with reference to the 5- and 2- minutes which was the real outstanding point of issue though it could not be said to be the main point. Mr. Asquith paid a tribute to the hearty co-operation of both sides of the House and intimated that the committee stage would contribute to night but there would be no sitting to-morrow (Saturday).

Mr. Ramsey MacDonald on behalf of the Miners' Federation said that the men would attend the negotiations which he hoped would result in an agreement without which the bill was useless.

Shipping Combine.

DETTED BY Y. A. O. CHAIRMAN.

London, March 29. Sir Thomas Sutherland in a statement said he had absolutely no knowledge of negotiations between the Peninsular and Oriental Co. and others with a view to combination.

The "Shipping Gazette" referring to the rise of shipping stock says the negotiation is proceeding between firms connected with the Australian and New Zealand Conference, including the Blue Funnel Line, with a view to making agreements insuring the peaceful working of the Australian and China trades.

Super-Dreadnought Launched.

London, March 29. The Duchess of Sutherland has launched the super-dreadnought Ajax Greenock. The vessel is of 23,091 tons and will have a speed of 23 knots.

Overdue Steamer.

London, March 29. Thirty-five per cent is quoted at Lloyd's for the steamer "Arguing" which is overdue from Natal to Java.

Rhodesian Cotton.

London, March 29. Ten bales of Rhodesian cotton have been sold in Liverpool at 7 1/4 p. pound.

Austrian Dreadnought.

Vienna, March 29. The Austrian dreadnought "Liberator" of 30,300 tons has been launched at Trieste.

Coal Dust Explosion.

New York, March 29. At a coal dust explosion at Salton mine, Oklahoma 107 people were entombed. All twenty are abandoned. Rescuers have located twenty bodies which cannot be recovered.

German Armaments.

EXPENDITURE INVOLVED.

Berlin, March 29. The additional naval and military expenditure involved by the new Defense Bill is £4,800,000 sterling in 1912, and £6,350,000 in 1913. The Army Bill provides for two additional army corps with the attachment of a machine gun company to each infantry regiment and the increase during peace to the effective army of 25,000 men.
